- I, Alan L. Friedman, Ph.D., being first duly sworn, on oath deposes and states as follows:
- 1. I have a Ph.D. in Molecular Genetics and Cell Biology, granted in 1985 by the University of Chicago, Division of Biological Sciences and Pritzker School of Medicine.

)

- 2. I have testified as an expert in Forensic DNA and Biology in seventy-five (75) cases. Forty-nine (49) of these have been in Wisconsin courts and the remainder have been in course in Illinois, Louisiana, Kentucky, Ohio and Maryland, Texas, Florida, Michigan, Minnesota and United States Federal courts.
- 3. I am a current member of the Criminalistics section of the American Academy of Forensic Science, International Society for Forensic Genetics, the Midwestern Association of Forensic Science and the American Association for the Advancement of Science.

- 4. I am currently the president of Helix Biotech, Inc. (DBA Helix Consulting) at 6650 W State St, Suite 327, Milwaukee, WI 53213. From 1996—2008, I was the laboratory director of Helix Biotech, Inc, a paternity and criminal forensic DNA laboratory, in Milwaukee, WI.
- 5. A copy of my CV is attached as Exhibit A to the Affidavit.
- 6. Biological samples containing DNA were collected from Leonard Pozner (Alleged Father 1) and Veronique Patricia De La Rosa (Mother).
- 7. A biological sample from Noah Samuel Pozner (M.E. Case No. 12-17604) was provided by the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner,11 Shuttle Road, Farmington, CT 06032.
- 8. An affidavit establishing chain of custody for the DNA samples is attached as Exhibit B to this affidavit.
- These samples were DNA profiled by Independent Forensics DNA Testing &
 Technologies, 500 Waters Edge, Suite 210, Lombard, IL 60148, a laboratory accredited
 for parentage testing by the American Association of Blood Banks (AABB) and ANSI
 (American National Standards) ISO/IEC 17025 forensic accreditation.
- 10. The results of the DNA analysis are attached as Exhibit C to this affidavit.
- 11. Leonard Pozner cannot be excluded as the biological father of Noah Samuel Pozner. The combined probability of paternity (genetic odds in favor of paternity), compared to a random, unrelated man of the same race, is over 672 million (672,722,851). The probability of paternity, assuming a 50% prior probability, is over 99.99%.
- 12. The testing evaluated 18 DNA locations, or loci. One of those is the amelogenin gene, reflected in Ex. C as "AMEL". That gene allows one to determine if the sample was taken from a male or a female. Ex. C shows data in the "X" column for the "Mother" sample, but no data in her "Y" column. That is to be expected for a sample from a female. Ex. C shows both an "X" and "Y" column for the "Child" and "Alleged Father." That is to be expected for males, who have both and X and Y chromosome. Thus, I can state with a reasonable degree of scientific certainty that Noah Samuel Pozner, the child from whom the medical examiner's office took its sample, was a male.
- 13. In my expert opinion, Leonard Pozner is, to a reasonable degree of scientific certainty, the biological father of Noah Samuel Pozner.

14. I have read the foregoing affidavit and acknowledge the contents thereof and affirm under penalty of perjury I truthfully executed the same for the purposes therein expressed.

The combined paternity index (genetic odds in favor of paternity) of the alleged father, compared to a random, unrelated man of the same race, is 672,722,851. The probability of paternity, assuming a 50% prior chance, is 99.99%.
