AFFIDAVIT OF JAMES FETZER, Ph.D.

I, James Fetzer, being first duly sworn upon oath, depose and state as follows:

1. I am an adult resident of the State of Wisconsin residing at 800 Violet Lane, Oregon, WI 53575.

2. I make this Affidavit based upon personal knowledge.

Books

3. Mike Palecek and I co-edited the 1st edition of a book named *Nobody Died at Sandy Hook: It was a FEMA Drill to Promote Gun Control* (2015) (the “Book”).

4. The 1st edition of the Book was initially available for sale on Amazon. CreateSpace, a subsidiary of Amazon, owned the International Standard Book Number (the “ISBN”).

5. The ISBN is a unique number assigned to each separate edition of a publication and it determines ownership of a book. For example, a paperback book will have a different ISBN than the hardcover version of the same book.

6. The ISBN for the 1st edition of the Book is ISBN 978-1518650840.
7. The 1st edition of the Book was banned from Amazon. CreateSpace owns the ISBN for the 1st edition of the Book, not me.
8. When the 1st edition of the Book was banned, I distributed a PDF version of the 1st edition of the Book (the “PDF Version”) for free.
9. My only connection to any version of the Book is that I edited the original content of the Book and released the PDF Version for free prior to the commencement of Plaintiff’s lawsuit.
10. I do not believe that I have an ownership interest in the books listed in Exhibit 1 of the The Affidavit of Randy J. Pflum In Support Of Plaintiff’s Motion For Order Of Turnover Of Defendant’s Property To Satisfy Judgment, filed with the Court on April 26, 2022 as Docket No. 491 (The “Pflum Affidavit”).
11. Going in order of the list of books listed in Exhibit 1 of the Pflum Affidavit, to the best of my knowledge, “*Nobody Died At Sandy Hook*, 1st Edition (2015)”, was banned from Amazon, cannot be sold or distributed anywhere, and has no monetary value. I believe the 1st edition of the Book ceased to exist after it was banned by Amazon.
12. Second, to the best of my knowledge, “*Nobody Died At Sandy Hook*, Banned Edition (2015)” likewise cannot be sold or distributed and has no monetary value.
13. Third, to the best of my knowledge, “*Nobody Died At Sandy Hook*, PDF Edition (2015)”, has no value and cannot be distributed by me.
14. Lastly, “*Nobody Died At Sandy Hook*, 2nd Edition (2016)” was published by Wrongs Without Wremedies, LLC (“WWW”), d/b/a Moon Rock Books Publishing, and WWW would have obtained the ISBNs for the 2nd and any subsequent editions of the Book.

15. I do not have an ownership interest in WWW or Moon Rock Books Publishing. A true and correct copy of the Articles of Organization and 2022 Annual Report for WWW and the Application for Registration of Fictitious Name of Moon Rock Books Publishing is attached hereto and its contents are incorporated herein and by reference as **Exhibit A**.

16. I would like to emphasize that any content that I edited, which Plaintiff argues I own, has no value to apply to Plaintiff's Judgment. There are two reasons for this: (a.) I would need to obtain a new ISBN, printer, and publisher in order to create and sell a book using the original content, and (b.) I am unable to distribute the content related to any of the books, due to the litigation between Plaintiff and myself.

17. I do not receive or expect to receive payments or royalties from the Books, ever, unless the Supreme Court of the United States were to reverse the judgments currently in place.

Domain Names

18. The Pflum Affidavit, Exhibit 1, cites four domain names (the "Domain Names"), of which, to the best of my knowledge and belief, I currently own none.

19. At the time of the Supplemental Examination of James H. Fetzer and Janice E. Fetzer, held before Commissioner Bryan Cahill on March 3, 2020, at Godfrey & Kahn, S.C., One East Main Street, Suite 500, Madison, WI, 53703 (the "Supplemental"), I stated that I at one time mistakenly believed I was a co-owner of Moon Rock Books Publishing with David Gahary. *See Supplemental*, a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto and its contents incorporated herein and by reference as **Exhibit B**, at 37:21-38:4, 38:20-39:1, 53:1, 75:6-18.

20. At the Supplemental, I mistakenly stated that I co-owned certain domain names (*Id* at 82:9-83:1, 83:13-20), but after further research I discovered that I do not own any of the domain names.

21. To the best of my knowledge and after research of online records, I have never had an ownership interest in the Domain Names listed in Exhibit 1 of the Pflum Affidavit.

22. Upon information and belief based upon my internet search, www.jamesfetzner.net and www.falseflagnews.org are available for purchase on the open market. A true and correct copy of my internet search results are attached hereto and its contents are incorporated herein and by reference as **Exhibit C**.

23. Based upon my internet search, it appears to me that www.falseflagnews.net has a registrar name under Perfect Privacy LLC. I do not own Perfect Privacy LLC. I do not know the owner of www.falseflagnews.net, and I do not own the domain name. A true and correct copy of my internet search results are attached hereto and its contents are incorporated herein and by reference as **Exhibit D**.

24. Based upon my internet search, WWW owns www.jamesfetzner.org. The registrar name for the domain name www.jamesfetzner.org is namecheap.com. I do not own WWW or namecheap.com. A true and correct copy of my internet search results are attached hereto and its contents are incorporated herein and by reference as **Exhibit E**.

25. I manage my website at www.jamesfetzner.org but I do not own the domain name that Plaintiff is requesting I turn over to him. I cannot turn over a domain name that I do not control or own.

26. I do not presently receive or expect to receive payments or royalties from the content of my website.

27. This Affidavit is submitted in response to Plaintiff's Motion For Turnover Of Property To Apply Property To Satisfy Judgment, filed with the Court on April 26, 2022 as Docket No. 490.

3 COMMISSIONER CAHILL: Sitting here

 21 MR. PFLUM: Jan. Maiden name?
 22 MS. JANICE FETZER: Morgan.
 23 MR. PFLUM: Janice Morgan?

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1 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes.
 2 MR. PFLUM: As Jeff is looking
 3 through your accounts, I'm going to just ask

 5 type of financial accounts.
 6 MS. JANICE FETZER: Okay.
 7 MR. PFLUM: Do you have a checking
 8 account?
 9 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yes.
 10 MR. PFLUM: An escrow account?
 11 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 12 MR. PFLUM: And do you escrow for
 13 taxes?
 14 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 15 MR. PFLUM: Savings account?
 16 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes.
 17 MR. PHILLIPS: And where are the
 18 checking and savings accounts held, which
 19 bank? I mean, I see the statements, but --
 20 MR. JAMES FETZER: They're all in
 21 there. Go ahead.
 22 MS. JANICE FETZER: I have --
 23 originally we were in Summit. We had
 24 everything at Summit Credit Union, but a new
 25 credit union opened in Verona, which is where

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1 our daughter lives. And we're there all the
 2 time, so in December we switched to the
 3 UW Credit Union. I still have some accounts
 4 open that we haven't closed yet, but they
 5 have minimum amounts of money in them at
 6 Summit.
 7 And then Jim has two accounts, one at
 8 Summit that he gets some business money in
 9 and the other at State Bank of Cross Plains
 10 where he does stuff for paying for the
 11 lawyer, legal --
 12 MR. JAMES FETZER: It's a legal
 13 defense fund.
 14 MS. JANICE FETZER: I think that's
 15 it.
 16 MR. PFLUM: Do you have any mutual
 17 funds?
 18 MS. JANICE FETZER: Mutual funds.
 19 I don't know exactly what that is.
 20 MR. JAMES FETZER: We have a Schwab
 21 portfolio.
 22 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
 23 MS. JANICE FETZER: His retirement
 24 money is all we have.
 25 MR. PFLUM: Do you invest in any

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1 investment clubs or with any investment
 2 clubs?
 3 MS. JANICE FETZER: No, no.
 4 MR. PFLUM: And the Schwab
 5 portfolio, is that a pension/profit sharing
 6 or anything like that?
 7 MS. JANICE FETZER: It is a
 8 rollover IRA from his retirement. And it
 9 rolled over from TIAA-CREF. And then he
 10 still has some in TIAA-CREF. They wouldn't
 11 let us roll over all of it. So we have some
 12 in Schwab, some in TIAA-CREF.
 13 MR. PFLUM: Okay. Mrs. Fetzter, is
 14 there a trust that you keep your money in?
 15 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 16 MR. PFLUM: Is there a money market
 17 that you use to keep your money in?
 18 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 19 MR. PFLUM: A brokerage?
 20 MS. JANICE FETZER: No, just
 21 Schwab, our retirement money.
 22 MR. PFLUM: Do you have a health
 23 savings account?
 24 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 25 MR. PFLUM: As to each of the

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1 accounts, in whose name or names are they in?
 2 MS. JANICE FETZER: They're in
 3 joint.
 4 MR. PFLUM: Joint.
 5 MS. JANICE FETZER: I take that
 6 back. They're not in joint. The retirement
 7 money is in Jim's name. Both the TIAA-CREF
 8 and the Schwab are in Jim's name. Our joint
 9 checking account is at UW Credit Union, and
 10 we have a joint checking account at the
 11 Summit. Those are joint. But his other
 12 two accounts, his business account at Summit
 13 and the one at State Bank of Cross Plains, is
 14 only in his name.
 15 MR. PFLUM: Okay. And the Summit
 16 is the --
 17 MR. JAMES FETZER: It's just a
 18 checking account only in my name.
 19 MS. JANICE FETZER: Summit Credit
 20 Union.
 21 MR. PFLUM: And where is that?
 22 Which Summit is that?
 23 MR. JAMES FETZER: Fitchburg.
 24 MR. PFLUM: Fitchburg. Okay. And
 25 the State Bank of Cross Plains --

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1 MR. JAMES FETZER: Cross Plains, in
 2 Oregon.
 3 MR. PFLUM: Oregon. And you
 4 provided documents showing the -- reflecting
 5 the account number on the State Bank --
 6 MR. JAMES FETZER: All of the
 7 above.
 8 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes. I gave
 9 all account numbers.
 10 MR. PFLUM: All right. Speaking
 11 only to Jim's Summit and State Cross Plains
 12 bank accounts, when did you last put money
 13 into that bank account?
 14 MR. JAMES FETZER: Jeez. There's
 15 not much going on there. I can't remember
 16 when the last thing I deposited was.
 17 MS. JANICE FETZER: It might be on
 18 the --
 19 MR. JAMES FETZER: It might be in
 20 the records.
 21 MS. JANICE FETZER: I sent the bank
 22 statements.
 23 MR. JAMES FETZER: I think there
 24 was maybe a donation to the legal defense
 25 fund a month ago or something like that. I

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1 mean, no recent, very recent activity. And I
 2 can't remember the last time I put anything
 3 in the Summit.
 4 MR. PFLUM: You said you use one
 5 for your business account?
 6 MR. JAMES FETZER: What Jan meant
 7 is if I receive royalties from Moon Rock
 8 Books, then I would put them into that
 9 account.
 10 MR. PFLUM: Which account?
 11 MR. JAMES FETZER: The Summit.
 12 MR. PFLUM: And the State Bank of
 13 Cross Plains --
 14 MR. JAMES FETZER: That's a legal
 15 defense fund. It's just donations that come
 16 for the legal defense. We've given you a
 17 breakdown of all of that.
 18 MR. PFLUM: Okay. When did you
 19 last take money out of the Summit account or
 20 the legal defense account?
 21 MR. JAMES FETZER: I can't --
 22 MS. JANICE FETZER: You wrote a
 23 check yesterday.
 24 MR. JAMES FETZER: Oh, I wrote a
 25 check yesterday for you for FedExing some

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1 documents like this. So, yeah, yesterday I
 2 wrote a check against it.
 3 MR. PFLUM: How much was that for?
 4 MR. JAMES FETZER: 200 and --
 5 MS. JANICE FETZER: 10.
 6 MR. JAMES FETZER: \$210. And
 7 22 cents?
 8 MS. JANICE FETZER: 27.
 9 MR. JAMES FETZER: Jan asked me how
 10 many pennies.
 11 MR. PFLUM: Again, I'm sure this
 12 question is reflected in the documents,
 13 but --
 14 MR. JAMES FETZER: Right.
 15 MR. PFLUM: -- what is the balance
 16 in the Summit account?
 17 MR. JAMES FETZER: We've got them
 18 there. Didn't you have them, Jan?
 19 MS. JANICE FETZER: He's got them.
 20 MR. PHILLIPS: I've got the
 21 statements here through it looks like August
 22 of 2019; is that right?
 23 MS. JANICE FETZER: No. It should
 24 be new ones.
 25 MR. PHILLIPS: Well, I don't see

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1 them in the folder here. Maybe they're in a
 2 different folder.
 3 MS. JANICE FETZER: What folder is
 4 that?
 5 MR. PHILLIPS: Moon Rock bank
 6 statements.
 7 MS. JANICE FETZER: Okay. It's in
 8 the other bank statements.
 9 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay.
 10 MS. JANICE FETZER: Let's see.
 11 No. 2.
 12 MR. JAMES FETZER: The Moon Rock
 13 bank statements, you just --
 14 MS. JANICE FETZER: It's in either
 15 No. 2 or 3. I'm not sure which the bank
 16 statements are in. 2 is you just wanted the
 17 account numbers. Those are the account
 18 numbers.
 19 MR. PHILLIPS: So I've got the
 20 account numbers.
 21 MS. JANICE FETZER: Okay. And then
 22 No. -- can I look at it? I can give you a
 23 number.
 24 MR. PHILLIPS: And No. 3 is
 25 retirement. I've got that here.

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1 MS. JANICE FETZER: Okay.
 2 MR. PHILLIPS: No. 4 is the house.
 3 So what typically happens for these, just to
 4 clarify this, is that you -- we've asked for
 5 a lot of information. It's kind of hard to
 6 gather all of that ahead of coming in. What
 7 we'll typically do from here is adjourn it to
 8 another date. You usually don't have to show
 9 up again, but we'll ask your attorney to
 10 produce the information that might be
 11 missing.
 12 MS. JANICE FETZER: Okay.
 13 MR. PHILLIPS: One of which might
 14 be the Summit Credit Union if they're not
 15 here.
 16 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yeah. Give me
 17 that a minute. Let me see that. Because I
 18 think I wrote in here from his checkbook what
 19 it was. James' bank, Summit Credit Union.
 20 He has \$156.06 at the last statement. And it
 21 should be in there somewhere, in one of
 22 those.
 23 MR. PHILLIPS: Sure.
 24 MR. JAMES FETZER: Now, just for
 25 disambiguation, when I initially moved to

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1 Summit, I mistakenly had it down as Moon Rock
 2 Book account because that was -- but that was
 3 just money coming to me, and it wasn't
 4 actually a business account. So I changed
 5 it, to clarify, to just James H. Fetzer. So
 6 Jan -- sometimes it says -- if it says
 7 Moon Rock Book account, she's really talking
 8 about just my personal checking account.
 9 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay.
 10 MR. JAMES FETZER: The one which
 11 has the sum she just read.
 12 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
 13 MS. JANICE FETZER: It has \$156.06.
 14 And then his bank account --
 15 MR. JAMES FETZER: The legal
 16 defense.
 17 MS. JANICE FETZER: -- the legal
 18 defense fund, has \$744.93.
 19 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay.
 20 MS. JANICE FETZER: And then I can
 21 give you a balance on the others too.
 22 They're all here. I've got them all here.
 23 MR. PHILLIPS: If they're all
 24 written down --
 25 MS. JANICE FETZER: I've got them

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1 written down under each account as of -- the
 2 bank account at the UW Credit Union is
 3 flexible because Jim gets -- at the first of
 4 the month we get \$1,700 from his retirement
 5 money. And then the second Wednesday we get
 6 our Social Security. And then I pay the
 7 bills. That's the only money I have to pay
 8 bills with. So it fluctuates as to according
 9 to when the bills come in.
 10 MR. PHILLIPS: Sure. And that
 11 money is all protected from the collection
 12 efforts, as your attorney's probably told
 13 you.
 14 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes. But I can
 15 give you the amounts, how much they are.
 16 MR. PHILLIPS: That's okay. I
 17 don't need those amounts right now.
 18 To just clarify something that you told
 19 Randy, for the Moon Rock Books account, is
 20 Moon Rock Books -- you said it's a business
 21 account. Is it organized as an LLC or a
 22 corporation or anything?
 23 MR. JAMES FETZER: No. That's what
 24 I was explaining. It's actually owned by
 25 Dave Gahary, who was a third defendant under

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1 the Wrongs Without Wremedies. Dave is the
 2 owner. I merely am -- I mean, I'm the editor
 3 for the books and receive royalties. But I
 4 had set it up as Moon Rock Books account
 5 because that was the primary source of the
 6 money, but it's not a business account.
 7 So I have to clarify that. I've changed
 8 it, put it into my own name. But all that
 9 is -- the legal stuff is all in the case I'm
 10 sure. It's under Wrongs Without Wremedies,
 11 who is the owner. I think it is an LLC of
 12 some kind.
 13 MR. PHILLIPS: Can you spell Gahary
 14 for us.
 15 MR. JAMES FETZER: G-a-h-a-r-y. He
 16 was a third of the defendants in the suit
 17 before he settled.
 18 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay.
 19 MR. PFLUM: You mentioned this
 20 earlier. During the past five years did you
 21 close any of the types of accounts mentioned
 22 earlier?
 23 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, we --
 24 go ahead, Jan.
 25 MS. JANICE FETZER: I have not

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1 closed them. I still have the Summit open.
 2 I haven't closed it yet. And I have --
 3 because I'm moving everything from Summit to
 4 the UW. And the Summit -- I have a savings
 5 account for \$100.31 I have left in. My
 6 checking account has \$102.74. And there's
 7 another second savings account that I started
 8 for our granddaughter, and it has \$25 in it.
 9 And so the rest of it has gone over to the --
 10 MR. PFLUM: UW?
 11 MS. JANICE FETZER: -- UW Credit
 12 Union.
 13 MR. JAMES FETZER: When you say
 14 five years, I moved from State Bank of
 15 Cross Plains, my accounts, to Summit. It may
 16 have been five years ago. Do you remember
 17 when we --
 18 MS. JANICE FETZER: Maybe. Yeah,
 19 closing, yes.
 20 MR. JAMES FETZER: I wanted it out
 21 of a bank into a credit union.
 22 MR. PFLUM: Mr. Fetzter, do you have
 23 the power to draw or sign checks on accounts
 24 of -- on any account that's not been
 25 mentioned?

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1 MR. JAMES FETZER: No.
 2 MR. PFLUM: Mrs. Fetzter?
 3 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 4 MR. PFLUM: Do either of you have a
 5 safe deposit box?
 6 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 7 MR. PFLUM: Do either of you have
 8 an account with any stockbroker or commodity
 9 broker?
 10 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 11 MR. PFLUM: Do either of you have
 12 the power of attorney or authority over any
 13 other bank account?
 14 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 15 MR. PFLUM: I'm going to ask you
 16 some questions about marriage and family.
 17 You both are married, correct?
 18 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yes.
 19 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes.
 20 MR. PFLUM: Do you have any
 21 children?
 22 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes. We have a
 23 total of four.
 24 MR. PFLUM: Four children?
 25 MR. JAMES FETZER: It's a modern

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1 marriage. I have a son from my first
 2 marriage. Jan has two daughters from her
 3 first marriage. And we have a daughter from
 4 our marriage.
 5 MR. PFLUM: And their names?
 6 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, my son is
 7 Brett, Brett L. Fetzter. He resides in
 8 Seattle. And of course Sarah. Jan,
 9 go ahead.
 10 MS. JANICE FETZER: My daughter
 11 Melanie -- do you need her last name?
 12 MR. PFLUM: Yes.
 13 MS. JANICE FETZER: Groth,
 14 G-r-o-t-h. And she lives in Bloomington,
 15 Indiana. And Michele Ress, with one L,
 16 Michele with one L, R-e-s-s, and she lives in
 17 Bloomington, Indiana. And then our daughter
 18 Sarah Lederer, L-e-d-e-r-e-r. She lives in
 19 Verona.
 20 MR. PFLUM: Okay. And their ages?
 21 I'm assuming they're --
 22 MS. JANICE FETZER: Okay. Melanie
 23 was born in '61. Brett was born in '65.
 24 Michele was born in '67. And Michele was --
 25 Sarah was born in '79.

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1 MR. PFLUM: Okay. And,
 2 Mrs. Fetzter, where do you work?
 3 MS. JANICE FETZER: I don't.
 4 MR. PFLUM: Have you ever worked?
 5 MS. JANICE FETZER: In and out of
 6 different places.
 7 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
 8 MS. JANICE FETZER: Not since I
 9 lived in Florida, which was in the mid '80s.
 10 MR. PFLUM: So you derive your
 11 income primarily from the \$1,700 from Jim's
 12 pension or the Schwab retirement?
 13 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes.
 14 MR. JAMES FETZER: Social Security
 15 and the pension are our sources of income
 16 except for royalties, intermittent royalties.
 17 MR. PFLUM: How much do you get for
 18 Social Security?
 19 MS. JANICE FETZER: I get \$874, and
 20 Jim gets \$2,322.
 21 MR. PFLUM: We've sort of touched
 22 on this at the beginning. Just to confirm,
 23 you both reside at the address in Oregon?
 24 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yes.
 25 MR. PFLUM: And you both live

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1 together at that address in Oregon?
 2 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes.
 3 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yes.
 4 MR. PFLUM: What are your average
 5 monthly expenses?
 6 MS. JANICE FETZER: I had them in
 7 there somewhere. It's in that one folder
 8 that I'm paying my bills with. There we go.
 9 Okay. So what do you need? Okay. What
 10 actually do you need?
 11 MR. PFLUM: I'm just looking at an
 12 average monthly expense.
 13 MS. JANICE FETZER: Well, it
 14 fluctuates because -- it depends on how big
 15 our Discover bill is, you know. If we go out
 16 to eat or we buy something, you know, it goes
 17 on a credit card. I usually -- I don't write
 18 checks for things. I put things on the
 19 credit card.
 20 We have a Discover credit card. I use a
 21 Chase for Jim to put some business things on.
 22 And we have a Target credit card, and now we
 23 have a UW Visa card. And all of those -- it
 24 just depends on -- I mean, like, this month I
 25 had --

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1 MR. JAMES FETZER: I think the
 2 answer is about \$5,000 a year -- a month,
 3 about \$5,000, wouldn't you say?
 4 MS. JANICE FETZER: I usually have
 5 some left over. Maybe \$4,000 a month. I'm
 6 not sure. I've got here a list of all the
 7 monthly bills that we have. Other than the
 8 credit card bills, of course I've got an
 9 electric bill. I've got our Spectrum TV and
 10 Internet bill. I have a telephone bill, you
 11 know, electric and gas and all that stuff.
 12 And then Jim fell -- how long ago was
 13 it? Several years, about four years maybe.
 14 MR. JAMES FETZER: What do you
 15 mean? When I tore my rotator cuff?
 16 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes.
 17 MR. JAMES FETZER: Oh, yeah,
 18 four years probably.
 19 MS. JANICE FETZER: Four or
 20 five years ago Jim fell and tore his rotator
 21 cuff and had to have surgery. And he has --
 22 doesn't have full movement in his arm, so we
 23 have had to hire someone to --
 24 MR. JAMES FETZER: Lawn and snow
 25 removal.

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1 MS. JANICE FETZER: In the summer
 2 to mow and in the winter to do the lawn. And
 3 that depends on the snow. Every week they
 4 come, and they mow for \$45 each time. They
 5 charge \$52 each time they come. And my last
 6 month with all the snow, our plowing bill was
 7 like 300 and some dollars because they -- if
 8 it's over two inches, they're there plowing.
 9 Then we have the house mortgage. We
 10 have health insurance. We have --
 11 MR. PFLUM: How much is your house
 12 mortgage?
 13 MS. JANICE FETZER: Our house
 14 mortgage is \$916.96, and that is not with
 15 taxes or anything. I don't do escrow.
 16 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
 17 MS. JANICE FETZER: And then we
 18 have health insurance. We have prescription
 19 insurance because Jim has -- Jim takes
 20 six prescriptions for his health problems.
 21 We have car insurance, and then we have
 22 dental insurance. So it all adds up. Some
 23 months are higher than others because the
 24 dental insurance only comes, like, every
 25 three months.

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1 MR. PFLUM: If I may, \$4,000 per
 2 month is a --
 3 MR. JAMES FETZER: Good estimate.
 4 MR. PFLUM: -- good estimate?
 5 MS. JANICE FETZER: Maybe a little
 6 over some months.
 7 MR. PFLUM: All right. You're not
 8 receiving any maintenance or child support or
 9 anything like that?
 10 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 11 MR. PFLUM: These are the
 12 questions --
 13 MR. JAMES FETZER: No. We
 14 understand.
 15 MR. PFLUM: -- we have to ask.
 16 MR. JAMES FETZER: They're all
 17 purpose.
 18 MS. JANICE FETZER: I put this
 19 (indicating) in by accident. That's the one
 20 I pay every month. I mark it off as I pay my
 21 bills.
 22 MR. PHILLIPS: Sure.
 23 MR. PFLUM: So now I'm going to ask
 24 you some questions about your home.
 25 MS. JANICE FETZER: Okay.

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1 MR. PFLUM: You own, correct? You
 2 don't rent?
 3 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes.
 4 MR. PFLUM: And who owns the house?
 5 How is it titled?
 6 MS. JANICE FETZER: It's joint.
 7 MR. PFLUM: So James and
 8 Janice Fetzer. Okay. When was the home
 9 purchased?
 10 MS. JANICE FETZER: 2006.
 11 MR. PFLUM: And how much did it
 12 cost?
 13 MS. JANICE FETZER: 235.
 14 MR. PFLUM: And whose money was
 15 used to purchase the home?
 16 MS. JANICE FETZER: He's the only
 17 one who has money, Jim. We sold our house in
 18 Minnesota actually.
 19 MR. PFLUM: And when did you sell
 20 your home in Minnesota?
 21 MS. JANICE FETZER: '06 also.
 22 MR. PFLUM: 2006.
 23 MS. JANICE FETZER: That was the
 24 year he retired. He retired, and we sold the
 25 house and moved to Wisconsin.

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1 MR. PFLUM: Do you have any
 2 boarders or subtenants?
 3 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 4 MR. PFLUM: You don't rent or lease
 5 any property?
 6 MS. JANICE FETZER: Oh -- no.
 7 MR. JAMES FETZER: No.
 8 MS. JANICE FETZER: No. I was
 9 going to say we do lease property. This is
 10 hard to explain. We have a trailer in
 11 Lake Mills. And we own the trailer, but we
 12 do not own the land. Lake Mills owns the
 13 land because it's on a -- it's near the
 14 beach, so it's city owned.
 15 So we do lease every year. We lease the
 16 property and pay taxes to the city on it, but
 17 we own the trailer. We don't own the land.
 18 So we do lease as far as leasing the property
 19 for the trailer.
 20 MR. PFLUM: And how much is that
 21 lease?
 22 MS. JANICE FETZER: It's about -- I
 23 think it's \$616 four times a year, so it's
 24 about \$2,400, \$2,500. I put all those
 25 records in the files.

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1 MR. PFLUM: Okay. Now I'm going to
 2 shift focus and talk about business and
 3 employment. We've alluded partly to
 4 Mrs. Fetzer's employment.
 5 MR. JAMES FETZER: Sure.
 6 MR. PFLUM: So currently what is
 7 your occupation, Mr. Fetzer?
 8 MR. JAMES FETZER: I'm retired, a
 9 retired professor.
 10 MR. PFLUM: You don't consider
 11 editor of Moon Rock Books an occupation?
 12 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, it's what
 13 I'm doing. I'm spending a lot of time on it,
 14 but I don't think of it that way. I mean, I
 15 suppose you could, I mean, because I do
 16 receive intermittent royalties. So I suppose
 17 you could say editor.
 18 MR. PFLUM: How much time do you
 19 spend in that capacity as the editor of
 20 Moon Rock Books?
 21 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, it's a
 22 function of, you know, the individual book
 23 projects, so I don't know. What basis? What
 24 do you mean?
 25 MR. PFLUM: Would you consider it a

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1 full-time job or a part-time job?
 2 MR. JAMES FETZER: Oh, no. Oh, got
 3 yeah. No, no, just part-time, sure, very
 4 partial.
 5 MR. PFLUM: So 20 hours a week?
 6 MR. JAMES FETZER: Oh, less.
 7 MR. PFLUM: Less than 20 hours a
 8 week?
 9 MR. JAMES FETZER: Oh, far less,
 10 yeah, yeah, yeah, yeah. I mean, you know,
 11 when I'm on a project, it's a big deal to get
 12 the project done and get all the contributors
 13 in and do the editing. And then you might
 14 have a couple of the equivalent of 40-hour
 15 weeks.
 16 But since we founded the company in
 17 2015, we've published 12 books since 2015.
 18 And three of those were not my books but were
 19 monographs by other authors. So I've had
 20 nine books I think that I edited for
 21 Moon Rock, which is since 2015. So it's a --
 22 you know, this -- it's not -- it's very
 23 concentrated when you're putting a book
 24 together, but it's the equivalent of a couple
 25 of weeks. But it's distributed because

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1 you're bringing in -- you know, contacting
 2 authors and all that sort of thing. But it's
 3 very partial. It's nothing resembling
 4 anything that would be full employment.
 5 MR. PFLUM: Thank you. What
 6 businesses have you conducted in the last
 7 five years?
 8 MR. JAMES FETZER: I'm sorry?
 9 MR. PFLUM: What businesses have
 10 you conducted in the last five years?
 11 MR. JAMES FETZER: That's it.
 12 MR. PFLUM: Just Moon Rock Books?
 13 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah. I can't
 14 think of anything else.
 15 MR. PFLUM: And are you a member of
 16 that organization?
 17 MR. JAMES FETZER: I'm the editor.
 18 MR. PFLUM: I understand that.
 19 MR. PHILLIPS: What he's asking is
 20 do you have any ownership interest?
 21 MR. PFLUM: Do you have any
 22 ownership interest?
 23 MR. JAMES FETZER: One time I
 24 thought -- Mike Palecek, who is the other
 25 defendant, and I founded Moon Rock Books, but

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1 Dave Gahary turns out to be the owner. For a
 2 long time I mistakenly thought I actually had
 3 an ownership, but I don't. Dave owns it, so
 4 I don't have an ownership.
 5 MR. PHILLIPS: How do you know
 6 that?
 7 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, we learned
 8 it through the legal process actually. I
 9 mean, I thought I was -- it's been foreign to
 10 me. But, you know, Dave had to have an
 11 attorney because he represented the company.
 12 You know, I couldn't even find an attorney,
 13 but he had to have one. It was all -- it's
 14 all in the court records if you want to dig
 15 into it.
 16 Because I don't have the ownership, I
 17 don't have the records to give you. But I'm
 18 sure Dave can provide them, and they're
 19 already in the record.
 20 MR. PHILLIPS: Sure. But to your
 21 knowledge you don't have any ownership
 22 interest in Moon Rock Books?
 23 MR. JAMES FETZER: Correct.
 24 MR. PHILLIPS: Your sole interest
 25 is just as editor?

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1 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yes.
 2 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay. And so how
 3 are you compensated as editor of Moon Rock
 4 Books?
 5 MR. JAMES FETZER: Intermittently
 6 by royalties from books sold.
 7 MR. PHILLIPS: So I'm going to make
 8 up a scenario here. Moon Rock Books sells
 9 some books. There's some royalties. And
 10 then you and Dave and Mike all share that?
 11 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, that was
 12 in the past, yeah. I think Mike's now out of
 13 it. Yeah, roughly that's right, yeah. But
 14 it's always -- we've always been very
 15 informal. I don't think we even have a
 16 formal written contract. Dave has a legal
 17 incorporation for the company, and that's why
 18 he was drawn into the lawsuit.
 19 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay.
 20 MR. JAMES FETZER: As having
 21 published the book.
 22 MR. PHILLIPS: So one of the
 23 documents that you've produced in response to
 24 our order is this royalty --
 25 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah.

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1 MR. PHILLIPS: And those are --
 2 MR. JAMES FETZER: That's a royalty
 3 from Oxford, isn't it?
 4 MS. JANICE FETZER: Oxford
 5 University Press.
 6 MR. PHILLIPS: So do you have any
 7 more royalties other than your --
 8 MR. JAMES FETZER: I have --
 9 MR. PHILLIPS: -- interest in
 10 Moon Rock Books?
 11 MR. JAMES FETZER: I have 40 books.
 12 MR. PHILLIPS: Yes.
 13 MR. JAMES FETZER: I gave you a
 14 complete rundown on all the publishers. I've
 15 had probably ten different publishers. And,
 16 frankly, you know, academic books in
 17 particular, which I have over two dozen,
 18 produce miniscule because they give you,
 19 like, 5 percent on the net. I mean, you
 20 know, people think if you publish a lot that
 21 brings a lot of income. Very rare.
 22 The Moon Rock Books is a more informal
 23 arrangement, but it gives a higher percentage
 24 in terms of royalties. I think you've got it
 25 all there.

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1 MR. PHILLIPS: Yes. So a lot of
 2 our questions are just we see what --
 3 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yes.
 4 MR. PHILLIPS: We see what's here.
 5 We just want to confirm.
 6 MR. JAMES FETZER: No, yeah. I'm
 7 with you.
 8 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay.
 9 MR. JAMES FETZER: I think you've
 10 been very cordial.
 11 MR. PHILLIPS: Well --
 12 MR. JAMES FETZER: Jan was so
 13 thorough, you know.
 14 MR. PHILLIPS: I see that. She was
 15 very good.
 16 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah. I was
 17 very impressed.
 18 MR. PFLUM: We appreciate that.
 19 Thank you.
 20 MR. PHILLIPS: But as far as your
 21 personal ownership of the license --
 22 MR. JAMES FETZER: I do not have --
 23 THE COURT REPORTER: One at a time,
 24 please.
 25 MR. PHILLIPS: Because when she's

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1 typing --
 2 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah, yeah. I
 3 get it.
 4 MR. PHILLIPS: But as far as your
 5 personal ownership of the book --
 6 MR. JAMES FETZER: Dave owns the
 7 company. I do not have --
 8 MR. PHILLIPS: -- copyright, or any
 9 sort of license, do you have any rights to
 10 that other than royalties?
 11 MR. JAMES FETZER: With Moon Rock
 12 Books?
 13 MR. PHILLIPS: With Moon Rock Books
 14 or anyone.
 15 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, as I
 16 explained in my answer to one, I have three
 17 recent books that are completely different
 18 where I have the copyright. But those are
 19 the only three books in which I have the
 20 copyright.
 21 MR. PHILLIPS: And I saw the
 22 document in here.
 23 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah.
 24 MR. PHILLIPS: So other than those
 25 three recent Moon Rock Books --

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1 MR. JAMES FETZER: Those aren't
 2 Moon Rock Books.
 3 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay. Other than
 4 that, those are -- the only continued
 5 copyright or any sort of legal interest in
 6 your books other than royalties are the
 7 three Moon Rock Books; is that right?
 8 MR. JAMES FETZER: No. Those are
 9 not Moon Rock Books. I just said my three
 10 most recent. I didn't mean to imply they
 11 were Moon Rock.
 12 MR. PHILLIPS: Oh, okay.
 13 MR. JAMES FETZER: They were
 14 independent. The guy just reached out to me.
 15 He liked what I did and wanted me to do books
 16 with him, and I have done three with him. I
 17 did the very first three at the top of the
 18 list because they're in a different category.
 19 Those are the only books in which I have the
 20 copyright.
 21 Now, I've been seeking to regain the
 22 copyright on some of my earlier books on JFK
 23 because they were very popular. And I should
 24 have them because they were published in
 25 1998, 2000, and 2003. But the publisher's

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1 been unable to retrieve the PDFs that would
 2 enable me to republish them as Moon Rock
 3 Books.
 4 MR. PHILLIPS: Sorry. Bear with me
 5 here.
 6 MR. JAMES FETZER: Sure.
 7 MR. PHILLIPS: Do you remember
 8 where -- and I remember seeing it in here.
 9 MS. JANICE FETZER: Which one are
 10 you looking for?
 11 MR. JAMES FETZER: The list of my
 12 publications.
 13 MR. PHILLIPS: Yes, the
 14 publications. He's got his CV in there
 15 and --
 16 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah, 18, 19,
 17 and 20 are in there.
 18 MS. JANICE FETZER: 18 -- yeah, the
 19 last file, 18 -- it was 18, 19, 20, and 21
 20 are all together.
 21 MR. PHILLIPS: Randy, why don't you
 22 continue, and I'll circle back here. Sorry.
 23 MS. JANICE FETZER: It's confusing
 24 to figure out where I put stuff.
 25 MR. PHILLIPS: Sorry.

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1 MR. PFLUM: I'm going to asking you
 2 some more questions about your books later
 3 on.
 4 MR. JAMES FETZER: Sure, sure.
 5 MR. PFLUM: Okay. What is the
 6 name -- what's the address of Moon Rock
 7 Books?
 8 MR. JAMES FETZER: Oh, it's all in
 9 there. It's Crestview in Florida. It's in
 10 every book. I don't know. I'm pretty
 11 certain we've got it in here somewhere.
 12 MR. PHILLIPS: Yes. I found it.
 13 MR. JAMES FETZER: 6562, Crestview,
 14 Bullet Drive, Crestview, Florida something.
 15 MR. PFLUM: Okay. And to your
 16 knowledge Moon Rock Books is organized and
 17 incorporated. Is it an LLC? What type of
 18 business entity is it? Is it an LLC or an
 19 incorporation?
 20 MR. JAMES FETZER: I think it's an
 21 LLC.
 22 MS. JANICE FETZER: When I get the
 23 tax form, the 10 -- I think I get a 1099 as
 24 to what they gave him. I think it lists as
 25 something Rights and something.

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1 MR. JAMES FETZER: Wrongs Without
 2 Wremedies with Ws, Wrongs Without W-remedies.
 3 MS. JANICE FETZER: It says LLC on
 4 the tax form.
 5 MR. JAMES FETZER: That's the
 6 umbrella within which Moon Rock Books is --
 7 MR. PFLUM: I understand.
 8 MR. JAMES FETZER: -- subsumed.
 9 MR. PFLUM: How much do you -- what
 10 is your -- how much do you earn in a given
 11 year, being as close to specific as possible,
 12 from your editing position?
 13 MR. JAMES FETZER: You mean how
 14 much do I get in royalties each year from
 15 Moon Rock Books?
 16 MR. PFLUM: Correct.
 17 MR. JAMES FETZER: Maybe a grand.
 18 MS. JANICE FETZER: Well, it's in
 19 the tax --
 20 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah, it's all
 21 in our tax forms to be real specific.
 22 MS. JANICE FETZER: And I haven't
 23 done taxes for this year. And I know he has
 24 sent me the tax forms, but I have not done
 25 taxes yet.

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1 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
 2 MR. JAMES FETZER: It varies, you
 3 know. It just depends how well they've been
 4 selling. There's so much censorship now that
 5 it's hard to reach our audience.
 6 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
 7 MR. JAMES FETZER: A couple grand
 8 maybe, you know, but it's in there.
 9 MS. JANICE FETZER: You make more
 10 than that. He makes more than that.
 11 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
 12 MS. JANICE FETZER: When I do the
 13 taxes, I get the tax forms, and I put in the
 14 amount. I can do it by TurboTax, and I put
 15 in the amount. And I think it's more than a
 16 couple thousand. He makes --
 17 MR. JAMES FETZER: It's not a large
 18 sum.
 19 MS. JANICE FETZER: This year for
 20 2019, the tax form I got, he made about
 21 \$25,000.
 22 MR. PFLUM: \$2,500 or --
 23 MS. JANICE FETZER: Thousand,
 24 \$25,000.
 25 MR. PFLUM: \$25,000. \$25,000?

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1 MR. JAMES FETZER: That was just
 2 because of the, because of the lawsuit,
 3 because of the settlement. Dave had to sell
 4 off the remainder stock of the book
 5 Nobody Died At Sandy Hook. And he did that
 6 at a premium because it was a closeout. I
 7 was there for the recipient of higher
 8 royalties than normal for that year, last
 9 year.
 10 I mean, a lot of people want to read the
 11 book.
 12 MR. PFLUM: Speaking of these
 13 royalties, how often, just ballpark, how
 14 often do these --
 15 MR. JAMES FETZER: It's just
 16 intermittent.
 17 MR. PFLUM: I understand
 18 intermittent, but --
 19 MR. JAMES FETZER: Dave calls. He
 20 handles the business. I don't do it. He
 21 just -- if he feels, you know, he should send
 22 some money, he sends some money, but I mean,
 23 he's the business guy.
 24 MR. PFLUM: So in just thinking of
 25 January, just for an example, January,

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1 February, March of this year, if --
 2 MR. JAMES FETZER: Of this year?
 3 MR. PFLUM: Speaking of just an
 4 example, if books were sold, when would you
 5 receive a royalty check?
 6 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, as I say,
 7 it's intermittent. It's just if he feels
 8 there's enough to justify it. I don't know
 9 that I got -- did I get any royalty checks
 10 this year? I don't think I have.
 11 MS. JANICE FETZER: I'm not sure.
 12 I think it was --
 13 MR. JAMES FETZER: I don't think I
 14 have.
 15 MS. JANICE FETZER: -- around 2019.
 16 MR. PFLUM: Speaking of 2019, just
 17 an average. I'm just trying to look -- just
 18 trying to get a baseline of how often you
 19 receive a royalty check.
 20 MR. JAMES FETZER: A couple times a
 21 year I would say, a couple times a year
 22 maybe. But it's totally informal. See, I
 23 mean, this is -- this is not a normal
 24 business. This is an effort to get --
 25 MS. JANICE FETZER: When he edits a

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1 book, he gets so much money for the book.
 2 And usually they'll send it then.
 3 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, Jan is
 4 thinking about academic books where you might
 5 get an advance, you know. I'm not getting
 6 any advances on this stuff. So we publish a
 7 book, and depending on how it sells, I might
 8 get a check two, three times a year. If
 9 there's some reason why we needed money, I
 10 could ask Dave Is there anything there? And
 11 Dave would see and send if there were.
 12 This thing with this closing out because
 13 of the book being -- having a settlement, I
 14 mean, that was extraordinary. I mean, that
 15 was just totally circumstantial as a function
 16 of the lawsuit.
 17 MR. PHILLIPS: If I can jump in.
 18 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah.
 19 MR. PHILLIPS: So is there a
 20 contract between you and Dave or you and
 21 Moon Rock Books that outlines how you get
 22 paid?
 23 MR. JAMES FETZER: No.
 24 MR. PHILLIPS: It's all just --
 25 MR. JAMES FETZER: All informal.

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1 MR. PHILLIPS: When you say
 2 informal, do you mean you talk to Dave?
 3 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah, sure.
 4 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay. So when
 5 you -- and I'm using this as an example.
 6 When you sold the last stock of the
 7 Sandy Hook book, how did Dave decide you were
 8 going to get \$25,000 and how much he was
 9 going to keep? How was that decision made?
 10 MR. JAMES FETZER: You'd have to
 11 ask Dave. I can't tell you the answer to
 12 that.
 13 MR. PHILLIPS: So you just received
 14 a \$25,000 check and said Thanks, Dave?
 15 MR. JAMES FETZER: No, I didn't get
 16 a \$25,000 check. I got -- I think there were
 17 three \$5,000 checks from that actually, not
 18 \$25,000. I don't know about the other 10
 19 that Jan was alluding to there for 25. But
 20 that was for the whole year because -- I
 21 mean, that would be a good year for us for
 22 Moon Rock Books obviously.
 23 MR. PHILLIPS: Sure. But to just
 24 kind of focus on that a little bit --
 25 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah.

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1 MR. PHILLIPS: -- you got a check
 2 for \$5,000?
 3 MR. JAMES FETZER: Right.
 4 MR. PHILLIPS: Did you say Thanks,
 5 Dave?
 6 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, of course.
 7 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay.
 8 MR. JAMES FETZER: He said Jim, I'm
 9 sending you some money.
 10 MR. PHILLIPS: What's the money
 11 for, Dave?
 12 MR. JAMES FETZER: No. We know
 13 what the money is for. I mean, we're talking
 14 all the time for crying out loud. I mean,
 15 Dave and I might -- sometimes we might talk
 16 five times a day, I mean, you know.
 17 MR. PHILLIPS: Sure. But why
 18 didn't you ask for more money than \$5,000?
 19 MR. JAMES FETZER: Because I'm
 20 not -- I'm not calling those shots. He's the
 21 business guy. I mean --
 22 MR. PHILLIPS: What if he sold the
 23 whole stock of books and gave you nothing?
 24 Then what would you do?
 25 MR. JAMES FETZER: I'd be

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1 surprised. I mean, he owns the company. We
 2 don't have a formal contract. Basically Dave
 3 could do whatever Dave wanted to do. I mean,
 4 he could I think perfectly legally within his
 5 rights. But we have a good working
 6 relationship. We had a good working
 7 relationship with Mike, but Mike is now
 8 basically signed out because he's -- the
 9 lawsuit.

10 MR. PHILLIPS: Sure. The reason I
 11 keep hammering this is that if I were an
 12 author and I were receiving a certain amount
 13 of checks, I'd kind of want to know why I was
 14 receiving the checks.

15 MR. JAMES FETZER: I know why I'm
 16 getting them. I mean, these are royalties on
 17 books we've been selling. I mean, look, I've
 18 been in the book business for a very long
 19 time. I published my first book in 1981.
 20 Now, those were all formal contracts with
 21 established publishers, Open Court, Oxford,
 22 D. Reidel, Kluwer, Springer, Paragon. I
 23 mean, I have a great deal of experience in
 24 the book business.

25 This was very different because this was

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1 really pursuing conspiracy research in order
 2 to get -- explain to the public what's been
 3 going on, where I bring together groups of
 4 experts to sort things out. And then we
 5 publish them as Moon Rock Books.

6 And would you believe of the 12 books
 7 that we publish at Moon Rock Amazon has
 8 banned six of them? Six of them. And
 9 obviously that affects, you know, the market.
 10 Because when the biggest book distributor in
 11 the world bans your books on political
 12 grounds and when YouTube is censoring -- you
 13 know, I may have had 100 videos censored
 14 by -- your plaintiff has been very active.
 15 He's boasted of taking down 1,555 YouTube
 16 videos.

17 He has boasted in an interview -- this
 18 is all in the record -- of being responsible
 19 for taking down tens of thousands of content
 20 items from the Internet. He's taken down
 21 everything he can about Sandy Hook and other
 22 events. So, I mean, we're hard-pressed to
 23 get the word out.

24 MR. PHILLIPS: Sure. But let's say
 25 he didn't do that, and there are a bunch of

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1 more books purchased by --
 2 MR. JAMES FETZER: Which would be a
 3 good thing, yes.
 4 MR. PHILLIPS: Sure. Let's say you
 5 sold a bunch more books, and you only got
 6 \$5,000 from Dave even though there were way
 7 more sales. What would you -- do you have
 8 any remedy against Dave to get more money, or
 9 are you just crossing your fingers that he
 10 pays you?
 11 MR. JAMES FETZER: Our relationship
 12 has been based on mutual trust. We don't
 13 have a formal agreement. I'm telling you
 14 Dave is the business guy.
 15 MR. PHILLIPS: And I'm just trying
 16 to clarify.
 17 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah, yeah. I
 18 got it.
 19 MR. PHILLIPS: Go ahead.
 20 MS. JANICE FETZER: They also use
 21 that money that they get from selling books
 22 to publish another book.
 23 MR. PHILLIPS: Right. Most
 24 businesses do. They don't just take all the
 25 money. They reinvest it.

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1 MR. JAMES FETZER: Sure, of course.
 2 MR. PHILLIPS: That's pretty
 3 common. I'm just trying to figure out --
 4 MR. JAMES FETZER: No. This is an
 5 unusually informal arrangement. You know, it
 6 just happened circumstantially, and kind of
 7 like Topsy, it just grew.
 8 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay. But just to
 9 reiterate, Dave's in full control?
 10 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yes.
 11 MR. PHILLIPS: Dave controls the
 12 money?
 13 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yes.
 14 MR. PHILLIPS: Dave decides who
 15 gets paid? Dave decides --
 16 MR. JAMES FETZER: What royalties
 17 are distributed, yes.
 18 MR. PHILLIPS: When the monies are
 19 reinvested to publish more books?
 20 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah. I mean,
 21 I'm actually pushing for more books. And
 22 Dave is in the position to control whether
 23 there are -- we've got several books in the
 24 works that I would have liked to have been
 25 published this last year. And they didn't

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1 largely because the lawsuit was diverting so
 2 much time, attention, and effort, you know.
 3 MR. PHILLIPS: And what are those
 4 books about?
 5 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, one is
 6 about Las Vegas, and another is about
 7 Kavanaugh, the court case.
 8 MR. PHILLIPS: Judge Kavanaugh?
 9 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah,
 10 ridiculous.
 11 MR. PHILLIPS: And when do you
 12 expect those books to be published?
 13 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, I'm hoping
 14 this year.
 15 MR. PHILLIPS: And what's the book
 16 about Las Vegas? What's the sort of thesis?
 17 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, it was a
 18 total sham. They had a prerecorded sound
 19 track that played over the PA system of
 20 machine gun firing. They had coordinated
 21 special effects. Yeah, it was a fraud.
 22 MR. PHILLIPS: You're talking about
 23 the Las Vegas shooting?
 24 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah. Nobody
 25 died in Las Vegas. We found the obituaries

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1 were based on persons who died in different
 2 states or on different dates or from
 3 different causes of death.
 4 MR. PHILLIPS: And do you have a
 5 relationship -- do you have -- is it the
 6 same -- when those books are published, is
 7 the same arrangement with Dave as the
 8 previous books, that --
 9 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah.
 10 MR. PHILLIPS: -- you publish these
 11 and --
 12 MR. JAMES FETZER: We give every
 13 contributor a complimentary copy of the book
 14 at \$100 for each chapter they contribute to
 15 the book. And I do the editing.
 16 MR. PHILLIPS: So for the \$100
 17 compensation to the contributors, is that
 18 all -- is that an agreement? Is that a
 19 contract, or is that --
 20 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, I write
 21 them and say, you know, We'd like to publish,
 22 and we'll give you \$100. I mean, I execute
 23 those things, and Dave's copied on them, you
 24 know.
 25 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay. So there is

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1 some agreement, at least between e-mails,
 2 between you and the contributors or you and
 3 Dave about how this money is going to be
 4 distributed?
 5 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah, but it's
 6 all standard. It's \$100 per chapter
 7 published in the book and a copy of the book.
 8 MR. PHILLIPS: And you don't have
 9 any e-mails between you and Dave regarding
 10 your own compensation, though, right?
 11 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, we're
 12 talking a lot. I don't know what to say
 13 about it.
 14 MR. PHILLIPS: And when you say
 15 talk, do you mean on the phone?
 16 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah, typically
 17 phone, Skype, whatever.
 18 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay.
 19 MR. JAMES FETZER: But, I mean, for
 20 the business end of it, you want Dave as your
 21 source.
 22 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay. Because
 23 that's what we're here for. We're trying to
 24 find out --
 25 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah.

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1 MR. PHILLIPS: I kind of understand
 2 the lawsuit. You know, I understand that
 3 part. But, you know, our job is to see what
 4 we can get from you essentially.
 5 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah, I know.
 6 MR. PHILLIPS: And so that's why --
 7 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah. You guys
 8 are very cordial. Go ahead.
 9 MR. PHILLIPS: And that's why we're
 10 asking these sorts of questions.
 11 MR. JAMES FETZER: Of course.
 12 MR. PHILLIPS: You know, I
 13 understand that there's not a whole lot of
 14 royalties coming in, but we still want to see
 15 the underlying agreements to the extent they
 16 exist. But it sounds like --
 17 MR. JAMES FETZER: There aren't any
 18 formal agreements. There's no formal
 19 contract.
 20 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay. Go ahead.
 21 MR. JAMES FETZER: I mean --
 22 MR. PFLUM: Okay. Just to button
 23 up the business employment side. To the best
 24 of your knowledge you are not a party to any
 25 kind of contract that entitles you to money?

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1 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah, there's no
2 formal contract, yes.
3 MR. PFLUM: Is there any type of
4 e-mail between you and Dave that discusses
5 payment on any of the books that you have
6 edited from Moon Rock?
7 MR. JAMES FETZER: Not offhand. I
8 mean, it wouldn't surprise me either way, but
9 we're recording everything using the tax
10 forms and so forth that has been received.
11 MR. PFLUM: If there is some type
12 of written agreement between you two, could
13 you please provide us with that?
14 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah. I'll look
15 to see if there is, but I'm very doubtful.
16 Here's what happened. I mean, I began the
17 very first book in 2015, was with
18 CreateSpace, which is a subsidiary of Amazon.
19 There was no Moon Rock Books. And we got it
20 out on the 22nd of October, and it had sold
21 nearly 500 copies before it was banned by
22 Amazon on the 19th of November.
23 And that's when Mike and I realized
24 that, you know, if Amazon was going to ban
25 our books on political grounds that we needed

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1 to have our own distributor. That's when we
2 went about founding Moon Rock Books. And now
3 they've banned six of them.
4 MR. PFLUM: Who prints the
5 Moon Rock Books?
6 MR. JAMES FETZER: Oh, Dave will
7 give you that stuff.
8 MR. PFLUM: You have no idea who
9 prints --
10 MR. JAMES FETZER: No.
11 MR. PFLUM: -- who the actual
12 printer is?
13 MR. JAMES FETZER: No.
14 MR. PFLUM: And then, finally, have
15 you ever obtained any license, franchise, or
16 permit?
17 MR. JAMES FETZER: For what?
18 MR. PFLUM: Any license. So if you
19 have a franchise -- so let's say, you know, a
20 McDonald's or something like that is a
21 franchise where you --
22 MR. JAMES FETZER: No, but I mean,
23 if you're talking about Moon Rock, I mean,
24 Dave's it.
25 MR. PFLUM: So now I'm going to ask

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1 you some questions about insurance.
2 MR. JAMES FETZER: Sure.
3 MR. PFLUM: Do you have -- and this
4 perhaps is best directed towards Mrs. Fetzter.
5 Do you have any accident, health, or life
6 insurance?
7 MS. JANICE FETZER: We have no life
8 insurance. We have house insurance. I have
9 health insurance. We have prescription
10 insurance, and we have dental insurance.
11 MR. PFLUM: And you provided us
12 with copies of all of that?
13 MS. JANICE FETZER: I'm trying to
14 think.
15 MR. JAMES FETZER: I don't remember
16 about insurance.
17 MS. JANICE FETZER: I don't think
18 there was anything in there about providing
19 anything on insurance. I can tell you how
20 much I spend on insurance.
21 MR. PFLUM: Okay. You haven't
22 attained any loans against any sort of
23 insurance policy, have you?
24 MS. JANICE FETZER: No. We have no
25 insurance policies, period.

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1 MR. PFLUM: So you are currently
2 receiving Social Security disability
3 payments?
4 MS. JANICE FETZER: Just
5 Social Security.
6 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
7 MS. JANICE FETZER: Now, we had
8 health -- or life insurance on Jim, but it
9 was only a term because Jim lost a kidney in
10 the middle '80s, and we could not get -- for
11 a long time we couldn't get any life
12 insurance. And then finally after about
13 ten years or maybe more they let us get term
14 insurance.
15 And then when he hit a certain age -- I
16 don't know if it was 72 or 75 -- they, like,
17 tripled the amount of payments for the -- to
18 keep the insurance. And we didn't have it in
19 the monthly. I did not have \$500 or \$600 to
20 pay for life insurance, so we cancelled. And
21 it was only a term. It was not a life.
22 MR. PFLUM: That never paid out
23 anything?
24 MS. JANICE FETZER: No, it did not.
25 MR. PFLUM: Okay. Now I'm going to

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1 ask you some questions about property.
 2 MS. JANICE FETZER: Okay.
 3 MR. PFLUM: Do you or your
 4 spouse -- do you own any antiques?
 5 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 6 MR. PFLUM: Automobiles?
 7 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes.
 8 MR. PFLUM: Okay. And what are
 9 those?
 10 MS. JANICE FETZER: We have a 2007
 11 Honda with over 200,000 miles.
 12 MR. JAMES FETZER: Accord,
 13 Honda Accord. Yeah, we checked the mileage.
 14 It's 209,409 as I recall.
 15 MR. PFLUM: It's serving you well.
 16 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah. It's a
 17 great car, yeah. We've had success with
 18 several Hondas. We had a couple Civics we
 19 really liked too, one of which was a Legacy.
 20 It went from us to our daughter, to her
 21 husband's sister. I mean, it was just
 22 chugging along.
 23 MR. PFLUM: Great. Do you own any
 24 boats?
 25 MR. JAMES FETZER: No.

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1 MR. PFLUM: No boats. So now I'm
 2 going to ask you some questions about the
 3 trailer in Lake Mills.
 4 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes. I got all
 5 that.
 6 MR. PFLUM: All right. So this is
 7 something that you -- this mobile home -- is
 8 it a mobile home?
 9 MS. JANICE FETZER: It's a mobile
 10 home.
 11 MR. PFLUM: Mobile home. Okay.
 12 MR. JAMES FETZER: It's an
 13 in-ground mobile home.
 14 MR. PFLUM: In-ground mobile home.
 15 MR. JAMES FETZER: It's got an
 16 attached screen porch.
 17 MR. PFLUM: When did you purchase
 18 that?
 19 MS. JANICE FETZER: In '08.
 20 MR. PFLUM: And how much did you
 21 purchase that for?
 22 MS. JANICE FETZER: We were trying
 23 to decide. I was thinking 57. Jim thought
 24 59. So it was either 57 or 59. I don't
 25 think on the deed it said what we purchased

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1 it for. I looked on it, and I don't think it
 2 said.
 3 MR. PFLUM: Is there any type of
 4 lien or any type of --
 5 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 6 MR. PFLUM: -- security interest
 7 against that --
 8 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 9 MR. PFLUM: -- mobile home?
 10 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 11 MR. PFLUM: Do they issue addresses
 12 for --
 13 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yep.
 14 MR. PFLUM: They do. What's the
 15 address?
 16 MR. JAMES FETZER: It's 11 Pines --
 17 MS. JANICE FETZER: It's P11.
 18 MR. PFLUM: P11?
 19 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah. There are
 20 three levels to the park, A, B, and the Pines
 21 it's called because we have so many trees.
 22 And it's 11P for Pines.
 23 MS. JANICE FETZER: Lake Mills.
 24 MR. JAMES FETZER: In Lake Mills,
 25 Wisconsin.

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1 MR. PFLUM: So the address is just
 2 simply 11P?
 3 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yeah.
 4 MR. PHILLIPS: Is it 11P Lake Mills
 5 Mobile Home, or is it 11P Lake Mills,
 6 Wisconsin?
 7 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, it could
 8 be Sandy Park.
 9 MS. JANICE FETZER: We don't get
 10 mail there. That's the problem.
 11 MR. PHILLIPS: Sure.
 12 MS. JANICE FETZER: Do you have the
 13 file on the mobile home?
 14 MR. PHILLIPS: Yes.
 15 MS. JANICE FETZER: Okay. I've got
 16 in there -- I've got something about the
 17 rental and the taxes and stuff, and that will
 18 probably --
 19 MR. JAMES FETZER: That will give
 20 you the address, yeah.
 21 MS. JANICE FETZER: You could
 22 probably put down Sandy Beach Road.
 23 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah.
 24 MS. JANICE FETZER: It's off
 25 Sandy Beach Road.

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1 MR. JAMES FETZER: In Lake Mills,
 2 yeah.
 3 MR. PHILLIPS: And it's in the
 4 Sandy Beach Mobile Home Park?
 5 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah, that's
 6 right.
 7 MR. PFLUM: How often do you stay
 8 there?
 9 MS. JANICE FETZER: Pardon?
 10 MR. PFLUM: How often do you stay
 11 there?
 12 MS. JANICE FETZER: It's only open
 13 from the middle of April until the middle of
 14 October because the City turns off the water
 15 during the winter because pipes freeze. So
 16 we are there mainly during the summer months,
 17 and we're only there on weekends. And
 18 probably last year we were there six or eight
 19 times all summer, the whole season.
 20 MR. PFLUM: I'm sorry. So between
 21 April and September?
 22 MS. JANICE FETZER: The 15th of
 23 April until the 15th of October.
 24 MR. PFLUM: October. I'm sorry.
 25 MS. JANICE FETZER: And we only go

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1 when our daughter and son-in-law and
 2 grandchildren are there because they're also,
 3 also there. And they're very busy, so they
 4 missed a lot this last summer. And we didn't
 5 go either.
 6 MR. JAMES FETZER: There were some
 7 years we were there a lot but not recently.
 8 They're so busy.
 9 MR. PFLUM: So this is like your
 10 vacation --
 11 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah, yeah.
 12 It's a little retreat, yeah.
 13 MR. PFLUM: But it's not like your
 14 main home?
 15 MR. JAMES FETZER: No, no, no.
 16 That's a 45-minute drive. You know, it just
 17 gets you away, and it's a real pretty
 18 setting.
 19 MS. JANICE FETZER: We bought it
 20 because our son -- or our daughter and
 21 son-in-law and two grandchildren have one.
 22 And originally when they bought it they
 23 didn't have any children, and then they had
 24 their first son. And he was in a
 25 Pack 'n Play, and we would stay in their

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1 guest bedroom.
 2 But then when he got old enough -- he
 3 was about a year and a half when he was
 4 getting too big for the Pack 'n Play. They
 5 were going to make the second bedroom his
 6 bedroom, so we ended up buying our own place.
 7 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
 8 MR. JAMES FETZER: It just happened
 9 to come available when we were in the market.
 10 MR. PFLUM: What's your estimate of
 11 the fair market value of the trailer today?
 12 MS. JANICE FETZER: Well --
 13 MR. JAMES FETZER: It's a depressed
 14 market.
 15 MS. JANICE FETZER: -- here's the
 16 deal. The City owns the property. They
 17 had -- they gave the homeowners association
 18 at the trailer park a ten-year contract with
 19 the City. Well, the ten-year contract
 20 expired several years ago. The City is only
 21 giving one-year contracts to the park because
 22 some of the city council members want to tear
 23 it out and put in condos thinking they'll
 24 make more money for the city than having
 25 these trailers. So they're only giving

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1 one-year contracts.
 2 So people who want to buy come out and
 3 look. We have a neighbor who's had theirs
 4 for sale now for two years. They come out
 5 and look, and they say Well, we've only got a
 6 year contract, you know. They may tear you
 7 out in a year. Most people won't buy. So
 8 we've got -- probably in the park there are
 9 probably at least 10 to 15 for sale all the
 10 time that aren't buying -- selling.
 11 MR. PFLUM: How much is your
 12 neighbor's listed for sale?
 13 MS. JANICE FETZER: They are listed
 14 at 60, maybe 65. They're larger. They have
 15 a three-bedroom, bigger trailer than ours.
 16 MR. JAMES FETZER: And a huge
 17 built-in porch and all that.
 18 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes.
 19 MR. PFLUM: So then circling back.
 20 How much do you think your trailer is worth?
 21 MS. JANICE FETZER: We will never
 22 get what we paid for it. If we could get --
 23 if we could get 50, I'd feel lucky, but I
 24 don't know. I have no idea.
 25 MR. JAMES FETZER: In this market

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1 I'd say 20 or 30 is probably closer, but
 2 there it is. They're not moving because of
 3 the circumstance Jan described, you know.
 4 MS. JANICE FETZER: And our trailer
 5 is a little newer. It was a '93, so that's
 6 why they were asking the 50-something for it,
 7 for ours. I know our daughter, they paid 35
 8 for theirs. So, you know, they range.
 9 There's some of them out there that have been
 10 there for 30 years.
 11 MR. JAMES FETZER: The neighbor is
 12 never going to sell his trailer for that
 13 price. It will sit there forever.
 14 MR. PHILLIPS: Just one follow-up.
 15 These trailers are movable if you make
 16 them --
 17 MR. JAMES FETZER: No. They're
 18 in-ground trailers.
 19 MR. PHILLIPS: Well, they can
 20 detach the water?
 21 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yeah, you
 22 can --
 23 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well,
 24 theoretically you could, but I mean, they're
 25 in the ground. They've got a foundation and

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1 all of that and attached porches. I mean --
 2 MR. PHILLIPS: But looking ahead to
 3 if the City decides to build condos, what do
 4 you anticipate doing with the trailer?
 5 MR. JAMES FETZER: God knows.
 6 MR. PHILLIPS: Trashing it or --
 7 MS. JANICE FETZER: We're not going
 8 to move it someplace else.
 9 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay.
 10 MR. JAMES FETZER: It's just all
 11 circumstantial for a little vacation thing
 12 with the kids, so --
 13 MS. JANICE FETZER: We would
 14 probably just lose our money on it because
 15 there's no --
 16 MR. JAMES FETZER: No viable
 17 alternative. Where would you put it?
 18 MS. JANICE FETZER: There's no
 19 place else to go with it.
 20 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay.
 21 MS. JANICE FETZER: I mean, we
 22 bought this because our grandchildren were
 23 there. And it's sort of a family thing. Our
 24 son-in-law's parents are there. Our
 25 son-in-law's sister and her family are there.

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1 Our son-in-law's aunt is there and another
 2 one. And so we're all there together. And
 3 if we all had to move, there's -- I don't
 4 know where they'd put trailers up anywhere.
 5 I think we just lose it.
 6 MR. PFLUM: We've already discussed
 7 this, but just to be clear, you don't own any
 8 interest in any business or enterprise or any
 9 joint venture that you're aware of?
 10 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 11 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yes.
 12 MR. PHILLIPS: Sorry.
 13 MS. JANICE FETZER: I said no, and
 14 he said yes.
 15 MR. PHILLIPS: Yes, you own, or no,
 16 you don't own?
 17 MR. JAMES FETZER: No, we don't
 18 own.
 19 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay.
 20 MR. JAMES FETZER: The question was
 21 You don't own it?, the way you phrased it, so
 22 I said yes to the negative.
 23 MR. PHILLIPS: Yes.
 24 MR. JAMES FETZER: I taught logic
 25 for 35 years.

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1 MR. PHILLIPS: Just clarifying the
 2 answers between you two.
 3 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yeah.
 4 MR. JAMES FETZER: Got it.
 5 MR. PFLUM: Do you own a coin
 6 collection at all?
 7 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 8 MR. JAMES FETZER: No.
 9 MR. PFLUM: How about a stamp
 10 collection?
 11 MR. JAMES FETZER: You know, I
 12 think I've got an old stamp collection from
 13 when I was a kid.
 14 MS. JANICE FETZER: I don't think
 15 so. It's not at our house.
 16 MR. JAMES FETZER: You don't think
 17 so?
 18 MS. JANICE FETZER: I've never seen
 19 it in 42 years.
 20 MR. JAMES FETZER: I used to have
 21 one.
 22 MS. JANICE FETZER: 42 years and I
 23 have not seen his stamp collection.
 24 MR. JAMES FETZER: I did once have
 25 a stamp collection. Whether I still have it,

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1 I have no idea.
 2 MR. PFLUM: Okay. So there's a
 3 possibility of a stamp collection out there?
 4 MR. JAMES FETZER: Don't ask me to
 5 look for it. Jesus, that would be
 6 horrendous.
 7 MR. PFLUM: How long did you
 8 collect stamps?
 9 MR. JAMES FETZER: Oh, a few years
 10 when I was in junior high or high school, as
 11 a kid.
 12 MS. JANICE FETZER: They were
 13 probably used.
 14 MR. JAMES FETZER: Oh, sure, of
 15 course.
 16 MS. JANICE FETZER: You didn't buy
 17 new stamps?
 18 MR. JAMES FETZER: No, no.
 19 MR. PFLUM: There weren't any
 20 stamps that were --
 21 MR. JAMES FETZER: No, God no.
 22 MR. PFLUM: There weren't any
 23 stamps -- I know I'm being a little tongue in
 24 cheek --
 25 MR. JAMES FETZER: That's all

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1 right.
 2 MR. PFLUM: -- but there weren't
 3 any stamps that were the "pride of your
 4 fleet" or anything like that?
 5 MR. JAMES FETZER: No, no, no, no
 6 special value, just an ordinary kid's
 7 collection.
 8 MR. PFLUM: How about certificates
 9 of deposit?
 10 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 11 MR. PFLUM: How about jewelry?
 12 MS. JANICE FETZER: I have a
 13 wedding band.
 14 MR. JAMES FETZER: Costume jewelry.
 15 MS. JANICE FETZER: Jim lost his
 16 wedding band.
 17 MR. PFLUM: Do you have any land
 18 contract interests?
 19 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 20 MR. PFLUM: Any livestock or farm
 21 implements?
 22 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 23 MR. PFLUM: Okay. So now we're
 24 going to talk about the books. Okay. So
 25 you, Jim, have said that you've published

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1 40 books?
 2 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah. I've
 3 given you a list of them all.
 4 MR. PFLUM: So you have a list of
 5 them all. Since 1970 how many books have you
 6 edited?
 7 MR. JAMES FETZER: How many books
 8 have I edited?
 9 MR. PFLUM: Yes.
 10 MR. JAMES FETZER: About 30 of
 11 those books are edited. Certainly more than
 12 two dozen are edited. There you go.
 13 MR. PFLUM: Okay. I know Moon Rock
 14 pays the royalties on the books. Who else
 15 pays royalties to you on the books that
 16 you've published?
 17 MR. JAMES FETZER: It's all in
 18 there.
 19 MS. JANICE FETZER: I had three --
 20 MR. JAMES FETZER: From
 21 Oxford University Press, Paragon. And what
 22 was the third publisher?
 23 MS. JANICE FETZER: Cricket.
 24 MR. JAMES FETZER: Cricket. That's
 25 all in court. But the royalties are trivial.

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1 I think Paragon just is a -- or Oxford just
 2 is a formality, you know, a statement, no
 3 royalties.
 4 MS. JANICE FETZER: I think we got
 5 a little --
 6 MR. JAMES FETZER: We put them all
 7 in there.
 8 MS. JANICE FETZER: We get a little
 9 bit of royalties from Oxford, but he still
 10 owes money to Paragon.
 11 MR. PHILLIPS: What does he owe
 12 money to Paragon for?
 13 MS. JANICE FETZER: Okay. They're
 14 educational books, okay? So when he
 15 publishes the book, they give him a contract,
 16 and they give him an advance. And then if
 17 the books don't sell, they take the -- they
 18 take his royalties out of his advance. So
 19 then --
 20 MR. JAMES FETZER: In other words,
 21 I'm paying it back.
 22 MS. JANICE FETZER: If they gave
 23 him \$5,000 and if they didn't make \$5,000 on
 24 the books, he's in the negative. And I think
 25 on Paragon he's still in the negative.

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1 MR. PFLUM: About how --
 2 MR. JAMES FETZER: It's an
 3 accounting, you know.
 4 MR. PFLUM: How much is he in the
 5 negative on for Paragon?
 6 MS. JANICE FETZER: It's in the
 7 records. I think I copied them.
 8 MR. JAMES FETZER: I don't think
 9 Paragon is even in -- well, I guess if we're
 10 still getting statements they're still in
 11 business.
 12 MR. PFLUM: Do you currently write
 13 any articles for any online website?
 14 MR. JAMES FETZER: Oh, God, yeah.
 15 MR. PFLUM: Which websites?
 16 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, my own
 17 blog has probably got 1,100 blogs that I've
 18 written.
 19 MR. PFLUM: And what's that blog?
 20 MR. JAMES FETZER: Jamesfetzter.org.
 21 MR. PFLUM: Do you earn any income
 22 from these articles?
 23 MR. JAMES FETZER: No.
 24 MS. JANICE FETZER: They just cost
 25 us money.

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1 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
 2 MR. PHILLIPS: How do they cost you
 3 money?
 4 MS. JANICE FETZER: Well --
 5 MR. JAMES FETZER: Just the
 6 periodic renewal of the domain name, that
 7 sort of thing. You know, Jan always raises
 8 questions, you know.
 9 MR. PHILLIPS: So for
 10 jamesfetzter.org, for jamesfetzter.net, for
 11 falseflagnews.org, for falseflagnews.net,
 12 those are domains that you own?
 13 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah, that I'm
 14 not using, though. I mean, I own them, but
 15 I'm not using them. Those are for potential
 16 projects for the future.
 17 MR. PHILLIPS: Is the only active
 18 domain name that you use james --
 19 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, I've got
 20 it down there. I apologize. Go ahead.
 21 MR. PHILLIPS: I forgot where I
 22 left off.
 23 Is the only active website that you
 24 publish to jamesfetzter.org, or are there
 25 other --

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1 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yes.
 2 MR. PHILLIPS: -- websites?
 3 MR. JAMES FETZER: And I have three
 4 others that are archival. They're all listed
 5 there at the end. I put the 18, 19, 20, 21
 6 together. Those are assassinationscience.com,
 7 assassinationresearch.com, and
 8 911scholars.org, all of which were active at
 9 one point but which are now only archival.
 10 I'm not doing anything with them. They're
 11 just there as a resource. You see -- yeah,
 12 there you got them.
 13 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay. The reason I
 14 ask is that you have the jamesfetzter.org
 15 active here, and then you list the three
 16 other domain names, but --
 17 MR. JAMES FETZER: But they're not
 18 active.
 19 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay.
 20 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah.
 21 MR. PFLUM: Thinking about these
 22 domain names, how much do you believe that
 23 these are worth?
 24 MR. JAMES FETZER: \$10. I mean,
 25 not much. I mean, you know, I only got them

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1 because I might do something with them.
 2 That's all. They're domain names. I mean --
 3 MR. PHILLIPS: You don't sell any
 4 ad --
 5 MR. JAMES FETZER: No, no, no, no.
 6 I don't monetize. I've never gotten a nickel
 7 out of any of this stuff.
 8 MR. PHILLIPS: Well, you've gotten
 9 the royalties from the books?
 10 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah, but we're
 11 talking about the Internet. We're talking
 12 about my website.
 13 MR. PFLUM: Do you sell your books
 14 on your website?
 15 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, there's an
 16 announcement for Moon Rock Books that appears
 17 intermittently.
 18 MR. PFLUM: So have you through
 19 your site, your website, your domain name
 20 jamesfetzter.org sold any books?
 21 MR. JAMES FETZER: I have not sold
 22 them. They are sold by Moon Rock Books. I
 23 do not sell them. I'm not a retailer. I'm
 24 an editor. I produce the books. Dave sells
 25 them.

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1 MR. PFLUM: So someone perusing
 2 your domain name would click on BOOKS, and
 3 then it would send them to Moon Rock?
 4 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, there's a
 5 menu on the bar which includes BOOKS. It
 6 includes VIDEOS and so forth. So, I mean,
 7 could they find an announcement of the books
 8 on where they could be purchased? Yes.
 9 MR. PFLUM: Okay. You don't get
 10 any type of kickback from Moon Rock Books for
 11 having your user --
 12 MR. JAMES FETZER: No.
 13 MR. PFLUM: Okay. What is
 14 153news.net?
 15 MR. JAMES FETZER: That's a website
 16 that is largely preserving freedom of speech
 17 and freedom of the press, contrary to YouTube
 18 and Google. In other words, it's more
 19 difficult for videos that are posted there to
 20 be taken down, similarly with BitChute,
 21 B-i-t-C-h-u-t-e. Those are two of the -- and
 22 they're more developing websites where you
 23 can post videos and feel they're relatively
 24 invulnerable to being taken down with all the
 25 massive censorship.

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1 MR. PFLUM: Do you receive any
 2 payment, any income from 153news.net for
 3 publishing or posting content to that domain
 4 name?
 5 MR. JAMES FETZER: No. It's the
 6 other way around. I give them money to keep
 7 them going. So it's the opposite.
 8 MR. PFLUM: How do you pay for
 9 jamesfetzer.org?
 10 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, we have a
 11 monthly -- I mean, a yearly whatever. Jan's
 12 paying it. You'll have to go through and
 13 look at it.
 14 MS. JANICE FETZER: I'm trying to
 15 think. I'm trying to think. His one
 16 account, the Chase credit card, he puts that
 17 kind of stuff on the Chase credit card. And
 18 when the credit card company -- I pay it off.
 19 I don't know what it is or what it's for,
 20 except it's for SiteGround, for whatever.
 21 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
 22 MS. JANICE FETZER: He does all
 23 that. I just pay the bills. And some things
 24 might go on Discover; some things might go on
 25 Chase. Mostly they -- but I pay off

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1 completely every credit card bill that comes.
 2 We owe no credit card bills.
 3 MR. JAMES FETZER: Jan pays them
 4 off every month.
 5 MR. PHILLIPS: That's good.
 6 MR. PFLUM: How much?
 7 MS. JANICE FETZER: How much what?
 8 MR. JAMES FETZER: You mean to pay
 9 for --
 10 MR. PFLUM: How much does it cost
 11 to maintain the jamesfetzer.org domain?
 12 MS. JANICE FETZER: I have no idea.
 13 MR. JAMES FETZER: Specifically?
 14 MS. JANICE FETZER: I have no idea.
 15 MR. JAMES FETZER: It might be a
 16 couple hundred a year. I don't know. I'm
 17 going to guess.
 18 MS. JANICE FETZER: I think -- I
 19 think the last one I got, a SiteGround thing,
 20 it was like under \$200.
 21 MR. JAMES FETZER: But I think
 22 SiteGround was for the others, the inactive
 23 ones, the archival, but we'd have to go back.
 24 MS. JANICE FETZER: I don't know.
 25 MR. PFLUM: Okay.

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1 MS. JANICE FETZER: It's not very
 2 much or we wouldn't be able to afford it. I
 3 wouldn't be able to pay it out of my monthly
 4 bills if it was very much.
 5 MR. PFLUM: Okay. We've discussed
 6 the real estate. The only real estate that
 7 you own is in Oregon, and that's your home?
 8 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes.
 9 MR. PFLUM: Are there any other
 10 notes or negotiable instruments that people
 11 owe you on, so a promissory note that --
 12 MS. JANICE FETZER: We had someone
 13 who owed us \$5,000 12 years ago. He never
 14 paid it. I got a thing from the court saying
 15 he went bankrupt. He can't pay us. We're
 16 not going to be able to collect. And then he
 17 died, so we never got our \$5,000. That was
 18 it.
 19 MR. PFLUM: Do you own any musical
 20 instruments?
 21 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 22 MR. PFLUM: Do you own any golf
 23 clubs?
 24 MS. JANICE FETZER: I bought Jim a
 25 set of golf clubs -- well, I bought him a

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1 case, empty case, and then I bought him some
 2 single clubs at Goodwill.
 3 MR. JAMES FETZER: Like 50 cents a
 4 club.
 5 MS. JANICE FETZER: I think I paid
 6 \$5 for the bag, and I paid like a dollar for
 7 the different clubs. And he doesn't golf
 8 because he's got a rotator --
 9 MR. JAMES FETZER: There's a course
 10 out there -- yeah, I can't with my arm now.
 11 But my son-in-law and his dad and I played
 12 some rounds out there, and it was great fun
 13 when I could swing a club. I don't think I
 14 can actually do it any longer. But it's
 15 just -- you know, we had the most fun because
 16 we didn't keep score.
 17 MS. JANICE FETZER: I couldn't sell
 18 it at a garage sale let's say.
 19 MR. PFLUM: Got it. I'm a century
 20 golfer myself.
 21 MS. JANICE FETZER: I buy
 22 everything used.
 23 MR. PFLUM: Understood. How about
 24 home entertainment equipment, like TV,
 25 computers?

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1 MS. JANICE FETZER: Okay. We have
 2 a TV. We got a brand new TV at Christmas.
 3 My two --
 4 MR. JAMES FETZER: That was a gift,
 5 a gift.
 6 MS. JANICE FETZER: My three
 7 daughters bought me a 50-inch Fire TV. They
 8 paid -- I looked it up. They paid \$269 for
 9 it, brand new. And we have computers.
 10 MR. JAMES FETZER: We have more
 11 TVs.
 12 MS. JANICE FETZER: Well, we have
 13 another TV. We have a 32-inch TV that we've
 14 had for ten years or so.
 15 MR. JAMES FETZER: And then
 16 downstairs we've got a little TV that's
 17 mounted up on the wall.
 18 MS. JANICE FETZER: It's a 12-inch
 19 maybe. Then let's see. We have -- what else
 20 did you ask?
 21 MR. JAMES FETZER: Computers.
 22 MS. JANICE FETZER: Computers.
 23 Okay. Jim has an iMac.
 24 MR. JAMES FETZER: On my desk.
 25 MS. JANICE FETZER: We bought it

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1 in -- I wrote it down somewhere -- 2015 or
 2 2016. He has a laptop that he bought in 2015
 3 or 2016. I had that in there. And then I
 4 have a computer. I've had it probably five
 5 or six years. I think that's it. I have an
 6 old computer, but it doesn't -- I can't get
 7 on the Internet with it. I was going to
 8 throw it away, but I use my scanner with it,
 9 so I kept it.
 10 MR. PFLUM: Okay. Do you have any
 11 judgments against anyone else? I'm not
 12 talking about the current judgment. I'm
 13 talking about separate judgments that you
 14 have against someone else.
 15 MS. JANICE FETZER: Okay. We sued
 16 someone in -- it was in Minnesota. And we've
 17 been here almost 14 years, so it was, you
 18 know, maybe 20 years ago. It was for a roof.
 19 And we won something like a judgment of
 20 \$3,700. They weren't paying us anything. We
 21 did small claims court. They didn't pay us
 22 anything, period.
 23 So we had the sheriff's department do a
 24 till tap. And they went in -- because they
 25 owned a flower shop. They did a till tap,

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1 and they got \$200. Plus, they took half of
 2 it or whatever. And then they sold their
 3 business, and they skipped town, and who
 4 knows where the hell they are.
 5 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
 6 MS. JANICE FETZER: They're gone
 7 forever.
 8 MR. PFLUM: Can you describe your
 9 mortgage. Who's your mortgage to?
 10 MS. JANICE FETZER: US Bank.
 11 MR. PFLUM: And how much is your
 12 mortgage for?
 13 MS. JANICE FETZER: Do you mean my
 14 payment, or how much do I owe?
 15 MR. PFLUM: How much left do you
 16 owe?
 17 MS. JANICE FETZER: Oh. 166,
 18 somewhere around there.
 19 MR. PFLUM: And how much is your
 20 home worth?
 21 MS. JANICE FETZER: Well, I was
 22 looking at the tax stuff they sent. They're
 23 saying like 278. It's hard to say.
 24 MR. PFLUM: Roughly 278?
 25 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah, right.

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1 MR. PFLUM: 280, somewhere around
2 there?
3 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yeah, maybe.
4 MR. PFLUM: Just for tax purposes.
5 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah.
6 MS. JANICE FETZER: I think that's
7 what we're taxed on. I'm not sure. I think
8 I sent the tax stuff with you.
9 MR. PHILLIPS: Yes. The tax bill
10 is in the documents. It's about 272,
11 something like that.
12 MS. JANICE FETZER: 272, yeah.
13 MR. PFLUM: Other than the Honda,
14 you don't own any other vehicles as far as --
15 MS. JANICE FETZER: We own a golf
16 cart.
17 MR. JAMES FETZER: We have a golf
18 cart, yeah.
19 MR. PFLUM: That's fine.
20 MS. JANICE FETZER: We answer fast.
21 MR. PFLUM: No boats, no planes,
22 no --
23 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
24 MR. PFLUM: But just a golf cart.
25 Okay. I assume you use that at Lake Mills?

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1 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes.
2 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
3 MS. JANICE FETZER: The thing is is
4 Lake Mills -- the beach is with the lake, and
5 then there's all these different areas where
6 we have trailers. And everyone has a golf
7 cart, and everybody takes their golf cart
8 around on the little -- it's not allowed to
9 be on the road. We're on the sidewalk or --
10 and to the beach is all we do.
11 MR. PFLUM: And how much did you
12 purchase that golf cart for?
13 MS. JANICE FETZER: I have it in
14 there. I think it was 35 something. We
15 bought it used. It's an '07.
16 MR. PFLUM: \$3,500?
17 MS. JANICE FETZER: Uh-huh. We
18 bought it in -- oh, gosh. I don't remember
19 what year we bought it.
20 MR. JAMES FETZER: Couple years
21 ago.
22 MS. JANICE FETZER: I got the thing
23 there. We've had it maybe three, four years.
24 MR. JAMES FETZER: It's ironic.
25 Since we've got it, we've hardly driven it

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1 because we just haven't been out there.
2 MS. JANICE FETZER: It's under the
3 V, in the Vehicle.
4 MR. PHILLIPS: You have a 2007
5 Yamaha Drive for \$3,500.
6 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yeah. And what
7 year did we buy it, though?
8 MR. PHILLIPS: 2017.
9 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yeah. I was
10 going to say it wasn't very long ago we
11 bought it.
12 MR. PFLUM: How much do you think
13 it's worth today?
14 MS. JANICE FETZER: I have no idea.
15 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
16 MR. JAMES FETZER: I don't know
17 either, but it might be a couple grand.
18 MR. PFLUM: Okay. How much do you
19 think your dependable Honda is worth?
20 MS. JANICE FETZER: Who knows.
21 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
22 MS. JANICE FETZER: We're never
23 going to be able to sell it because we can't
24 afford to buy a new car.
25 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah. It's

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1 perfect for us, but I don't think it would
2 have much resale value.
3 MR. PFLUM: Okay. This is
4 something that we ask everyone. How much
5 money -- how much cash do you have with you
6 today?
7 MS. JANICE FETZER: Today? Ooh.
8 Do you want me to add it up?
9 MR. PHILLIPS: A ballpark is fine.
10 MR. PFLUM: Ballpark is fine.
11 MS. JANICE FETZER: Oh, I've got
12 \$80 maybe -- \$60.
13 MR. JAMES FETZER: I've got \$106,
14 which I've been carrying around for a while.
15 I mean, we don't spend a lot of money.
16 MS. JANICE FETZER: We use the
17 credit card.
18 MR. PHILLIPS: Do you have any cash
19 in your mattress, under --
20 MS. JANICE FETZER: Nope, not
21 any -- that's it. I've got a penny jar.
22 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
23 MS. JANICE FETZER: That's got
24 about that much (indicating) in the bottom of
25 it.

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1 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, you've got
 2 some loose change.
 3 MS. JANICE FETZER: And I put my
 4 change in the penny jar.
 5 MR. PHILLIPS: So a penny jar but
 6 nothing buried in the back yard?
 7 MS. JANICE FETZER: Nope.
 8 MR. PFLUM: So just thinking about
 9 security interest or money that you owe to
 10 banks, it's only your mortgage on your house;
 11 that's the only secured pledged collateral
 12 that you've given to a bank?
 13 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes.
 14 MR. PFLUM: Okay. Other than the
 15 roofer who we won't see anymore and the
 16 individual you loaned money to, does anyone
 17 else owe you any money?
 18 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 19 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
 20 MS. JANICE FETZER: I try to keep
 21 him from giving money away. He always gives
 22 up --
 23 MR. JAMES FETZER: The problem is
 24 the flow in the other direction.
 25 MS. JANICE FETZER: He had some

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1 woman call him up. She had bugs under her
 2 skin, and the only doctor who would take care
 3 of her was in Mexico. And she needed \$800,
 4 and Jim sent her \$400. I don't let him
 5 answer the phone anymore.
 6 MR. PFLUM: Understood. Do you own
 7 any firearms?
 8 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes.
 9 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yes.
 10 MR. PFLUM: Can you describe those
 11 to me.
 12 MR. JAMES FETZER: Sure. I've got
 13 a shotgun, and I've got a little .22 handgun.
 14 MR. PFLUM: What are the -- what
 15 type of shotgun do you own?
 16 MR. JAMES FETZER: 10-gauge pump.
 17 MR. PFLUM: Who is the
 18 manufacturer?
 19 MR. JAMES FETZER: You know, I
 20 didn't look at it. It might be Remington.
 21 MR. PFLUM: How much did you
 22 purchase that for?
 23 MR. JAMES FETZER: 80 bucks or
 24 something. I don't know. It wasn't very
 25 expensive.

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1 MR. PFLUM: And just solely
 2 thinking about the .22, that's a handgun?
 3 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah. It's just
 4 a small -- yeah.
 5 MR. PFLUM: Who is the manufacturer
 6 on that?
 7 MR. JAMES FETZER: You know, I
 8 can't tell you. I'd have to go and look at
 9 it.
 10 MR. PFLUM: How much did you
 11 purchase that small handgun for?
 12 MR. JAMES FETZER: Well, I bought
 13 that used for more than it was worth. I
 14 actually -- I think I paid 300 bucks,
 15 280 bucks for it, ridiculous. I mean, I look
 16 back on it, and I say that was a silly
 17 purchase.
 18 MR. PFLUM: And those are the only
 19 two firearms that you own?
 20 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yeah.
 21 MR. PFLUM: Now I'm going to ask
 22 you some questions about financial
 23 statements.
 24 MS. JANICE FETZER: Okay.
 25 MR. PFLUM: Have you ever employed

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1 an accountant or a bookkeeper within the last
 2 five years?
 3 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 4 MR. PFLUM: And you provided us
 5 with tax returns, correct?
 6 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes.
 7 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
 8 MS. JANICE FETZER: Three years.
 9 MR. PFLUM: Three years. Okay.
 10 Great.
 11 MR. PHILLIPS: When do you think
 12 you're going to file your 2019 taxes?
 13 MS. JANICE FETZER: I was going to
 14 do it this month, but I've been busy doing
 15 other things. I'll do it sometime this month
 16 probably.
 17 MR. PHILLIPS: But before April 15?
 18 MS. JANICE FETZER: I always have
 19 it done before April 15.
 20 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay.
 21 MS. JANICE FETZER: So either I'll
 22 do it this month or I'll do it next month.
 23 I'll have it done before -- I've never been
 24 late. I do it on TurboTax, so I just have to
 25 put numbers in. It's easy.

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1 MR. PHILLIPS: Right. It's easier
 2 once you've -- when you file those, can you
 3 provide a copy to your attorney then to --
 4 MS. JANICE FETZER: Oh, you mean
 5 now?
 6 MR. PHILLIPS: Yes.
 7 MS. JANICE FETZER: This new one?
 8 MR. PHILLIPS: Yes.
 9 MS. JANICE FETZER: Okay. Sure.
 10 MR. PFLUM: Are you expecting any
 11 refunds for 2019?
 12 MS. JANICE FETZER: I have no idea
 13 until I'm done with it. We were getting
 14 refunds. Last year we did not because I
 15 changed the tax where you couldn't take
 16 deductibles and all this kind of stuff. And
 17 we had to pay a couple thousand probably,
 18 but --
 19 MR. JAMES FETZER: And because of
 20 the bump in royalties, we may wind up paying.
 21 MS. JANICE FETZER: We'll see. I
 22 don't know.
 23 MR. JAMES FETZER: I wouldn't be
 24 surprised.
 25 MR. PFLUM: Okay.

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1 MR. PHILLIPS: You'll probably wind
 2 up paying if you didn't withhold anything.
 3 MS. JANICE FETZER: They didn't --
 4 I don't think -- I don't think Dave withholds
 5 anything.
 6 MR. PHILLIPS: No grievance for
 7 that?
 8 MS. JANICE FETZER: He just sends
 9 the statement, and then there's nothing
 10 withheld on it at all.
 11 MR. PHILLIPS: Right.
 12 MR. PFLUM: So currently -- sorry.
 13 MS. JANICE FETZER: Go ahead.
 14 MR. PFLUM: Currently thinking
 15 about your taxes, do you owe any tax
 16 obligations to the IRS or the Wisconsin
 17 Department of Revenue?
 18 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 19 MR. JAMES FETZER: No.
 20 MR. PFLUM: Okay. Other than the
 21 present lawsuit, are you a plaintiff or a
 22 defendant in any other lawsuit?
 23 MR. JAMES FETZER: No.
 24 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 25 MR. PFLUM: Have either of you ever

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1 filed bankruptcy?
 2 MR. JAMES FETZER: No.
 3 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 4 MR. PFLUM: Have you ever made an
 5 assignment for the benefit of your creditors?
 6 MS. JANICE FETZER: What does that
 7 mean?
 8 MR. PFLUM: It means --
 9 MR. PHILLIPS: It means when you
 10 take your stuff, you give some of your
 11 personal assets to a creditor to satisfy a
 12 judgment.
 13 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 14 MR. PHILLIPS: It's not very
 15 typical for anyone in your position. Not for
 16 individuals or anything like that?
 17 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 18 MR. PFLUM: Have you ever made any
 19 payments on any judgments?
 20 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 21 MR. PFLUM: Have you ever been
 22 garnished?
 23 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 24 MR. PFLUM: Do you have a written
 25 will or a trust, an estate plan?

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1 MS. JANICE FETZER: We have a will.
 2 MR. JAMES FETZER: That we need to
 3 update.
 4 MS. JANICE FETZER: We're going to
 5 update it. I've got stuff to update it, so
 6 we're going to update a new will.
 7 MR. PFLUM: Have either of you
 8 inherited property?
 9 MS. JANICE FETZER: Oh, property.
 10 No.
 11 MR. PHILLIPS: Not just land but
 12 any kind of property.
 13 MS. JANICE FETZER: I've inherited
 14 money.
 15 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay.
 16 MS. JANICE FETZER: That's --
 17 MR. PHILLIPS: And do you expect to
 18 receive any more inheritances, either of you,
 19 anyone on their deathbed, any --
 20 MR. JAMES FETZER: No.
 21 MR. PHILLIPS: -- great-grandmas,
 22 great-aunts?
 23 MS. JANICE FETZER: All of our
 24 parents are deceased. We have no --
 25 MR. JAMES FETZER: I just lost my

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1 favorite aunt, but I don't expect to be a
2 beneficiary.
3 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
4 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay.
5 MR. PFLUM: So to the best of your
6 knowledge, you do not have any interest in
7 anyone else's estate?
8 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
9 MR. PFLUM: Are either of you
10 acting as an executor, an administrator,
11 trustee, personal representative, receiver,
12 or guardian for anyone?
13 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
14 MR. PFLUM: And that's a no for you
15 too, Jim?
16 MR. JAMES FETZER: Yes. Yes, that
17 is a no.
18 MR. PHILLIPS: And, Jim, what was
19 your aunt's name that just passed away?
20 MR. JAMES FETZER: Oh,
21 Nadine Barney, B-a-r-n-e-y. She just died
22 like two days ago.
23 MR. PFLUM: Sorry about that.
24 MR. PHILLIPS: Sorry about that.
25 MR. JAMES FETZER: I was glad --

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1 I've been sending her flowers, and I got them
2 in time. I'm very glad. She had a -- her
3 youngest daughter was caring for her for
4 about six months now. We knew -- we knew it
5 wasn't going to be much longer.
6 MR. PFLUM: Did she live in
7 Wisconsin?
8 MR. JAMES FETZER: No, no,
9 California.
10 MR. PFLUM: I'm going to ask you
11 some questions about transfers of property.
12 Have you ever assigned any cause of action to
13 anyone?
14 MS. JANICE FETZER: What does that
15 mean?
16 MR. JAMES FETZER: We wouldn't even
17 know.
18 MS. JANICE FETZER: What does that
19 mean?
20 MR. PFLUM: For instance, when Jim
21 fell and hurt himself, if he had a cause of
22 against a business.
23 MS. JANICE FETZER: Oh, he fell in
24 the front yard. No. We haven't had any of
25 that.

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1 MR. PHILLIPS: Go ahead.
2 MR. PFLUM: Have you sold or
3 transferred any property within the last
4 five years?
5 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
6 MR. PHILLIPS: So no garage sales,
7 no --
8 MS. JANICE FETZER: Nope.
9 MR. PHILLIPS: -- transfer --
10 haven't sold a thing, only purchased?
11 MS. JANICE FETZER: Nope.
12 MR. PHILLIPS: Okay.
13 MR. JAMES FETZER: Jan loves garage
14 sales, though.
15 MS. JANICE FETZER: I go to garage
16 sales, but I haven't had any garage sales. I
17 did when we moved down here.

19 MS. JANICE FETZER: Years ago.
20 MR. PFLUM: Okay. I'm going to ask
21 you some -- so what are your -- other than
22 US Bank, do you have any other -- and this
23 judgment, do you have any other liabilities?
24 MR. JAMES FETZER: No.
25 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes.

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1 MR. JAMES FETZER: Go ahead.
2 MS. JANICE FETZER: Be quiet. I
3 have them in there. I had a tooth
4 transplant, so I had surgeon bills and dental
5 bills. Insurance paid part, but I think on
6 the surgeon bills we owed something like
7 \$1,100. And then on the dental bills we owed
8 something like \$1,200. Well, I paid off
9 maybe half of them, but we -- and then Jim
10 had to get -- this last week he had to get --
11 MR. JAMES FETZER: A crown.
12 MS. JANICE FETZER: -- a crown.
13 And we don't know yet what the insurance paid
14 or what the insurance hasn't paid. So I'm
15 going to owe some to a surgeon and some to
16 the dentist. And that's it. That's all the
17 bills we have. I pay off credit card bills
18 as they come. We don't owe any bills
19 anywhere.
20 MR. PFLUM: So you're current --
21 just to confirm, you are current on your
22 payments to creditors?

24 pay the Discover bill and the Chase and the
25 Target bill and the other credit card bill

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1 the first of the month.

 3 made -- in the last year have you made any
 4 payments to what's called an insider, so a
 5 family member, a close relative?
 6 MS. JANICE FETZER: Paid money to
 7 them?
 8 MR. PFLUM: Yes.
 9 MS. JANICE FETZER: For what?
 10 MR. PFLUM: Have you made any types
 11 of --
 12 MS. JANICE FETZER: Transfer money?
 13 MR. PFLUM: A gift or --
 14 MS. JANICE FETZER: Oh, no, no. We
 15 bought our son -- or our grandson. We paid
 16 half for his saxophone, but that wasn't last
 17 year. It's been two years with the sax.
 18 Other than that, we haven't paid anything.
 19 MR. JAMES FETZER: Just Christmas
 20 presents, you know.
 21 MR. PFLUM: Okay.
 22 MR. JAMES FETZER: Birthday
 23 presents.
 24 MR. PFLUM: Have you ever had any
 25 property repossessed or foreclosed upon?

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1 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 2 MR. JAMES FETZER: No.
 3 MR. PHILLIPS: And you said you do
 4 your own taxes, right?
 5 MS. JANICE FETZER: Yes, I do.
 6 MR. PHILLIPS: You don't have any
 7 other financial planners or accountants or
 8 anything like that?
 9 MS. JANICE FETZER: No, no. We
 10 only hired someone to do it when Jim retired
 11 in '06 because we had -- we moved to
 12 Wisconsin, so we had, you know --
 13 MR. JAMES FETZER: Two states.
 14 MS. JANICE FETZER: -- two state
 15 stuff. We didn't know.
 16 MR. JAMES FETZER: And it was the
 17 one really complicated tax year we've had.
 18 MS. JANICE FETZER: And Jim knew
 19 someone in Duluth that did taxes that we
 20 used.
 21 MR. PFLUM: Thinking about this
 22 \$25,000 payoff or settlement on the book, how
 23 much of that do you have left?
 24 MR. JAMES FETZER: Wait. I don't
 25 know where the \$25,000 was -- it was --

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1 MS. JANICE FETZER: No.
 2 MR. JAMES FETZER: Go ahead, Jan.
 3 MS. JANICE FETZER: I got the form,
 4 you know, the tax form. It was 25 something.
 5 The money that -- a lot of it, at least
 6 \$15,000 of it that he sent, we had -- Jim has
 7 paid the lawyer. We have none of it left,
 8 period. We have -- the only money we have is
 9 what I get for Social Security, that plus the
 10 little tiny two accounts he has. The rest of
 11 it has gone to the lawyer that he got from
 12 book royalties -- from Moon Rock Books,
 13 rather.
 14 MR. PFLUM: Unless Jeff has any
 15 more questions, those are the questions that
 16 I have.
 17 MR. PHILLIPS: The last step here
 18 is -- I think I mentioned this at the
 19 beginning, that we just wanted to get -- we
 20 have to ask Bryan to get an adjourned date
 21 just in case we have additional questions
 22 after we take a full look at these.
 23 MS. JANICE FETZER: Okay.
 24 MR. JAMES FETZER: Sure.
 25 MR. PHILLIPS: Typically that

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1 doesn't happen, and we can sort it out with
 2 your attorney.
 3 MR. JAMES FETZER: Sure.
 4 MR. PHILLIPS: And hopefully we
 5 won't have to come back here.
 6 MS. JANICE FETZER: Okay.
 7 MR. PHILLIPS: But we'll call him
 8 back in to get that adjourned date.
 9 MR. JAMES FETZER: I just -- I
 10 think you guys are both extremely competent
 11 and very cordial. You know, you made this as
 12 painless as it could be.
 13 (Discussion off the record)
 14 COMMISSIONER CAHILL: While we were
 15 off the record the parties agreed that the
 16 supplemental exam is continued until May 5 at
 17 10 a.m. if necessary.
 18 (Adjourning at 11:47 a.m.)

Namecheap was founded by Richard Kirkendall in 2000.^[3]

In March 2013, Namecheap started to accept Bitcoin as a payment method.^[4]

In February 2022, Namecheap announced that they would terminate services to Russian accounts due to the Russian invasion of Ukraine, citing "war crimes and human rights violations". Existing users were given a one-week grace period to move their domains.^[5] The company also announced that it would be offering free anonymous domain registration and web hosting to all protest and anti-war websites in Russia or Belarus.^[6]

In July 2019, Namecheap was one of the organizations that filed a reconsideration request to ICANN asking to review the decision to remove price caps on .org and .info TLDs.^{[7][8]} As of September 2019, ICANN ignored such requests.^[9]
